Islam is entirely dependent on its revelator: Muhammad bin Abdullah. What sort of man was he? Was he, as described by believers, the best of men, the perfect role model for Muslims to emulate?

Lets take a look at Muhammad's character.

Sahih Bukhari Volume 7, Book 62, Number 64:

Narrated 'Aisha:

that the Prophet married her when she was six years old and he consummated his marriage when she was nine years old, and then she remained with him for nine years (i.e., till his death).

Sahih Muslim Book 019, Number 4436: It has been narrated on the authority of Jabir that the Messenger of Allah (may peace be upon him) said: Who will kill Ka'b b. Ashraf? He has maligned Allah, the Exalted, and His Messenger. Muhammad b. Maslama said: Messenger of Allah, do you wish that I should kill him? He said: Yes. He said: Permit me to talk (to him in the way I deem fit). He said: Talk (as you like). ... He then held his head fast and said to his companions: Do your job. And they killed him.

The Qur'an informs us that it is free of contradictions (4:82). That information is contradicted by the juxtaposition of two ayats: 2:256 | 9:33.

The Quran informs us that it contains divine knowledge (4:166). But 18:86 informs us that the sun sets in a muddy spring, with people living nearby.

The Hadith inform us that Muhammad was a pederast & suborner of murder. Can we believe that such a man accurately recited divine revelation?

The Qur'an tells us that it is **free of contradictions.** If that is not true, then none of it can be trusted.

4:82. Do they not then consider the Qur'an carefully? Had it been from other than Allah, they would surely have found therein much contradictions.

Consider the following ayats in the light of 4:82.

2:256. There is no compulsion in religion. Verily, the Right Path has become distinct from the wrong path....

9:33. It is He Who has sent His Messenger (Muhammad ) with guidance and the religion of truth (Islâm), to make it superior over all religions even though the Mushrikûn (polytheists, pagans, idolaters, disbelievers in the Oneness of Allâh) hate (it).

10:99. And had your Lord willed, those on earth would have believed, all of them together. **So, will you (O** 

Muhammad ) then compel mankind, until they become believers.

10:100. It is not for any person to believe, except by the Leave of Allâh, and He will put the wrath on those who are heedless.

"There is no compulsion in religion" <> "to make it superior over all religions even though the Mushrikûn (polytheists, pagans, idolaters, disbelievers in the Oneness of Allâh) hate (it). "

That contradiction spoils the entire book, yet it is not alone.

6:108. And insult not those whom they (disbelievers) worship besides Allâh, lest they insult Allâh wrongfully without knowledge. ...

9:30. And the Jews say: 'Uzair (Ezra) is the son of Allâh, and the Christians say: Messiah is the son of Allâh. That is a saying from their mouths. They imitate the saying of the disbelievers of old. Allâh's Curse be on them, how they are deluded away from the truth!

But the Qur'an contains no contridictions, which would disprove it's validity!!!

4:166. But Allâh bears witness to that which He has sent down (the Qur'ân) unto you (O Muhammad), He has sent it down with His Knowledge, and the angels bear witness. And Allâh is All-Sufficient as a Witness.

Thus we are informed that the Qur'an contains Allah's knowledge. Any false information contained therein must disprove Allah's status as Allknowing. But that is impossible, or is it?

18:86. Until, when he reached the setting place of the sun, he found it setting in a spring of black muddy (or hot) water. And he found near it a people. We (Allâh) said (by inspiration): "O Dhul-Qarnain! Either you punish them, or treat them with kindness."

The sun sets in a muddy spring, and there are people living nearby!!! Yeah, wrong.

The Quran demonstrably contains misinformation, which proves that it did not origionate with the omniscient creator of the universe!!
