The United Nations: Investigate the

televised, public hearings into Islam's

article:

"The Muslim world's two main political bodies  
say they are seeking a UN resolution, backed  
by possible sanctions, to protect religions after  
the publication in Scandinavia of cartoons  
depicting the prophet Muhammad.

Ekmeleddin Ihsanoglu, secretary-general of  
Organisation of the Islamic Conference, said in  
Cairo on Sunday that the international body

would "ask the UN general assembly to pass a  
resolution banning attacks on religious  
beliefs".

The deputy secretary-general of the Arab  
League, Ahmed Ben Helli, confirmed that  
contacts were under way for such a proposal  
to be made to the UN.

"Consultations are currently taking place at  
the highest level between Arab countries and  
the OIC to ask the UN to adopt a binding  
resolution banning contempt of religious  
beliefs and providing for sanctions to be  
imposed on contravening countries or  
institutions," he said."
