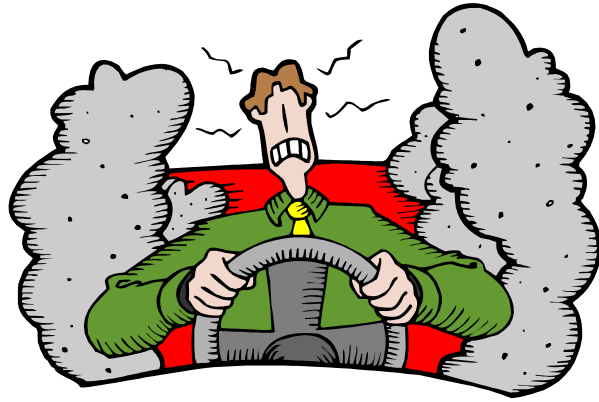

### \*To figure monthly fuel cost

Divide the miles driven per year by the miles per gallon the car gets in the city.

This give you the number of gallons of gas you will use per year if you drive 10,000 miles. Multiply that number by the present price per gallon of gasoline. This gives you the annual cost of fuel. Divide by 12.

The result is the money you will spend at the pump monthly.

Sale v. Lease- Leased cars are cheaper per month but that is because you only pay for the luxury of “renting the car”. You must turn the car in at the end of the lease term, and MAY have to PAY if the car is in less than perfect condition.
