AVID is a program of high academic expectations. The AVID elective class offers academic support and tutorial assistance. However, the AVID student must make every effort to keep academic performance and conduct at an acceptable level. If the AVID student's overall GPA falls below 2.0 or if the AVID class average is below a 77, automatic probation will result.

If the AVID student has: 1 OSS (out of school suspension), 2 ISS (in school suspensions), 2 ASD (after school detentions), or any combination of the above, automatic probation will result. Unacceptable conduct in any class or school are can also result in probation.

Other reasons for being placed on probation are listed below.
