FROM FREDERICTON / SAINT JOHN / ONTARIO / QUEBEC / USA • From Hwy #2 in New Brunswick, take exit 454 (Mapleton Road); at the end of the ramp turn right (arrow to Moncton). Continue straight on Mapleton Road to Mountain Road (Canadian Tire & Wendy's are on corner). Turn left and follow Mountain Road for about 4.7 Kms. Turn right onto **Vaughan Harvey Blvd.** Turn left at the next set of lights onto Edmonton Street. Follow Edmonton for 2 or 3 blocks and it becomes Essex St. There will be a long wooden fence on the left which ends at Club Beausejour.

FROM NOVA SCOTIA • From Hwy #2 in New Brunswick, take Exit 454 (Mapleton Road); at the end of the ramp turn left (arrow to Moncton). Continue straight on Mapleton Road to Mountain Road (Canadian Tire and Wendy's on corner). Turn left and follow Mountain Road 4.7 kms. Turn right onto **Vaughan Harvey Blvd.** At the next set of lights turn left onto Edmonton Street. Follow Edmonton for 2 or 3 blocks and it changes it's name to Essex St. There will be a long wooden fence on the left which ends at Club Beausejour.
