Eligibility: See below for age requirements. Age determined as of March 1, 2003. *First Place winners in 2002 solo events may enter non-competitively only.*

Accompanist: Student provides accompanist, other than teacher. Please do not assign accompanist until after you have received audition time, or request a special time of day. It is the teacher's responsibility to assign accompanists to avoid schedule conflicts.

Rules for String Solo, Competitive and Noncompetitive:

Solo performance must be from memory, except accompanist. Noncompetitive participants may use music.

Rules for Solo Guitar, Competitive and Noncompetitive:

Performance must be from memory. One or two compositions may be performed at all age levels.

A published copy of the music must be presented to the adjudicators.
