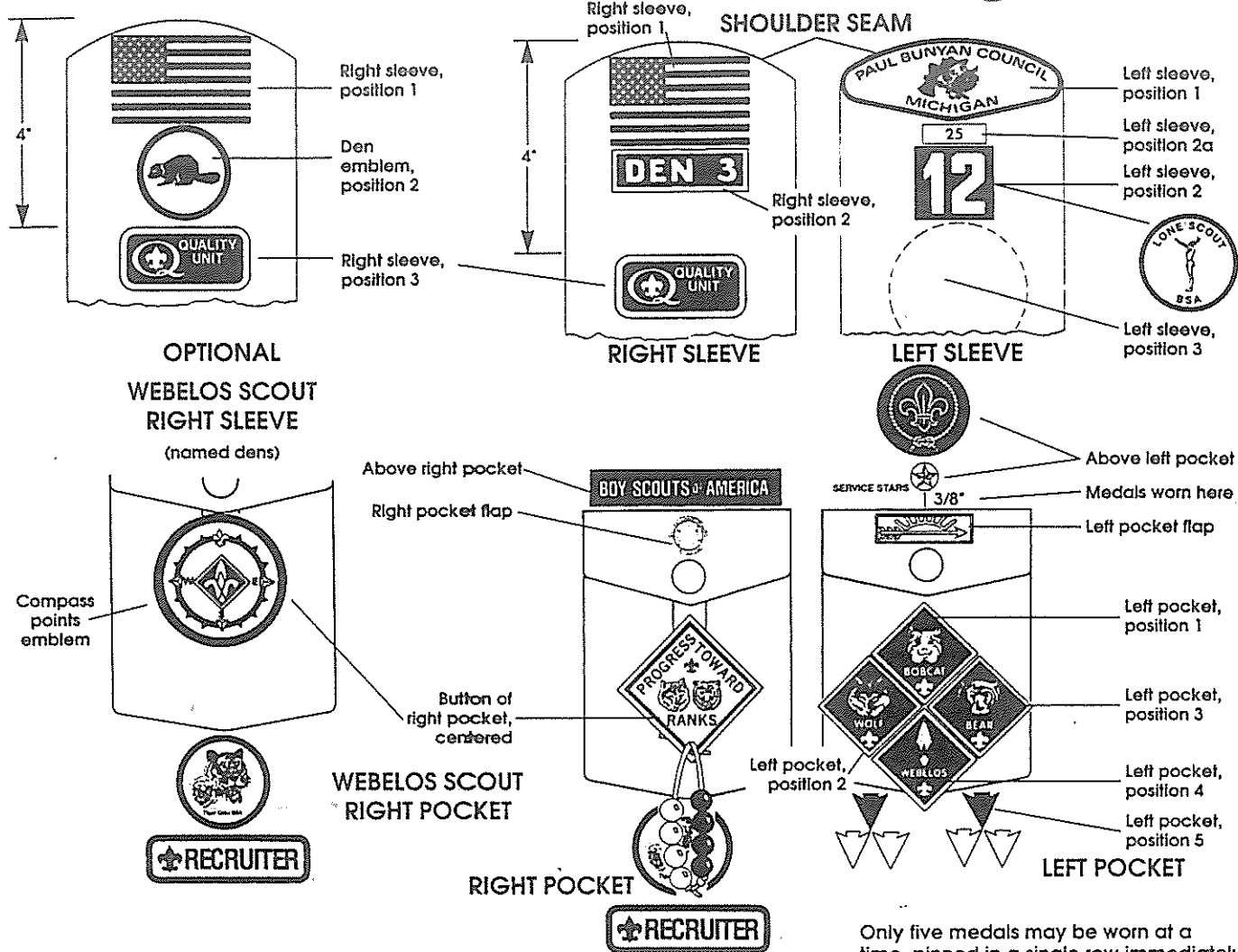


Cub Scout and Webelos Scout Insignia



CUB SCOUT PROGRAM IDENTIFICATION

U.S. flag emblem, cloth, red, white, and blue, No. 00103, Cub Scout, Cub Scout leader, right sleeve, position 1. New uniforms have this emblem already sewn in the correct position.

Council shoulder emblem, cloth, No. 16xxx (last three digits indicate the council number), Cub Scout and Cub Scout leader, left sleeve, position 1.

Unit number, cloth, white on red, Nos. 10400 through 10408 (last digit indicates the unit number for 0 through 8); for unit number 9, order No. 10406. Cub Scout and Cub Scout leader, left sleeve, position 2, touching council shoulder emblem if veteran unit bar is not worn. Multiple-digit numbers may be special-ordered—2-digit, No.

10409; 3-digit, No. 10410; 4-digit, No. 10411.

Lone Scout emblem, cloth, red and black on khaki, No. 00352, Lone Cub Scout, left sleeve, position 2.

Veteran unit bars, cloth, Cub Scout and Cub Scout leader, left sleeve, position 2a; 25 years, No. 00133; 50 years, No. 00105; 55 years, No. 00194; 60 years, No. 00195; 65 years, No. 00196; 70 years, No. 00197; 75 years, No. 00107; 80 years, No. 00198.

Den number, gold on blue, Nos. 10701 through 10724 (last two digits indicate the den number); Cub Scout, Webelos Scout, or den leader, right sleeve, position 2, immediately below and touching the U.S. flag.

Only five medals may be worn at a time, pinned in a single row immediately above the seam of the left pocket.

Webelos den emblem, optional (see page 17).

Neckerchief slide, No. 00800; Cub Scout, worn with Cub Scout neckerchiefs.

Neckerchief slide, No. 00891; Webelos Scout, worn with Webelos Scout neckerchief.

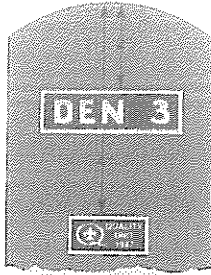
Bolo tie, No. 00830; Cub Scout leader, optional wear with open-collar shirt.

Shoulder loops, blue ribbon, No. 00677, Cub Scout leader or Webelos Scout, on shoulder epaulets.

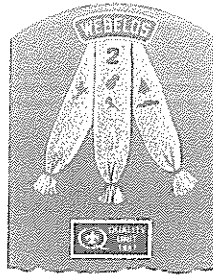
World Crest, cloth, No. 00143, centered horizontally over left pocket and vertically between left shoulder seam and top of pocket. May be worn by all members of Scouting as an expression of world brotherhood.

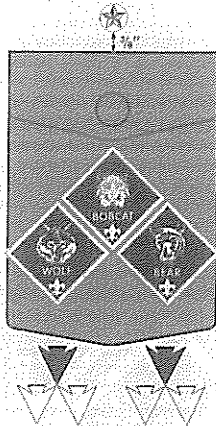

RIGHT SLEEVE



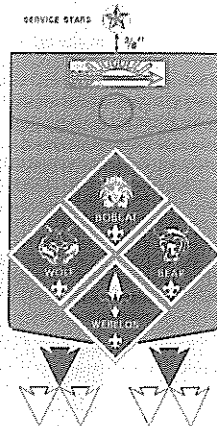
WEBELOS SCOUT

(blue or tan shirt)



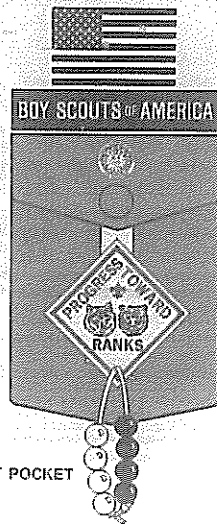
LEFT SLEEVE

Conduct uniform inspections with common sense; the basic rule is neatness.

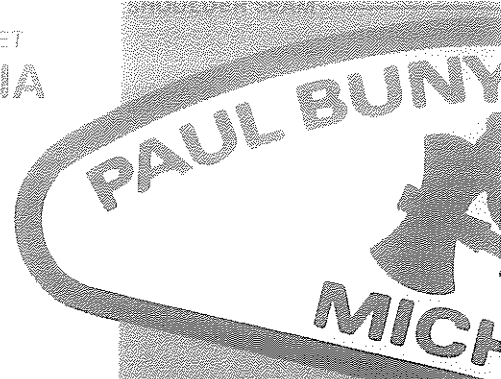
Right Sleeve. Cub Scout wears the den numeral. Webelos Scout wears the Webelos bar and colors. Webelos den numeral is worn on the gold color streamer as shown. Activity badges are worn in any order on any of the Webelos colors, but not more than seven badges on any one color. Both Cub Scouts and Webelos Scouts may wear the Quality Unit Award, if earned. If more than one Quality Unit Award is earned, it has been common practice to wear only the most recent three.

Left Sleeve. Wear council patch as shown. Pack numeral is worn directly below except when veteran unit insignia bar (25 or 50 years) is worn. That bar is worn centered below the council patch and above the numeral, and touches both. Denner cord or assistant denner cord is worn over left shoulder.

Left Pocket. Wear badges of rank as shown: Bobcat, Wolf, and Bear; Webelos Scouts add Webelos badge. The Arrow of Light Award (in metal or cloth) is centered on the flap. Gold arrow points are worn beneath the pocket and below the badge for which they were earned. Silver arrow points are worn below the gold arrow points in double rows. Wear medals just above pocket seam; and service stars centered just above medals, or 1/8 inch above seam if no medals are worn. Background disks worn with service stars are: gold for Cub Scout service; orange for Tiger Cub service. Not more than five medals may be worn. Wearing sequence for medals or knots is at the wearer's discretion. The only knots worn by Cub Scouts are the religious emblem knot and a lifesaving or meritorious award knot.

Right Pocket. U.S. flag is worn above Boy Scouts of America strip. Temporary insignia are not necessary in uniform inspection, but if worn, must be centered on the pocket. Progress Toward Ranks (with thong and beads) is fastened to button under flap of right pocket of Cub Scout uniform only and flap rebuttoned. The National Summertime Award is pinned centered on the right pocket flap.

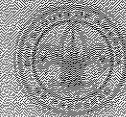
Khaki/Tan Webelos Scout Uniform. Webelos Scouts electing this option wear blue shoulder loops, Webelos neckerchief, and Webelos cap. Blue or khaki belt may be worn. Sports loops must be worn on the blue belt. Badge placement is same as for blue uniform.



Position above diagram on left sleeve to guide you on proper placement of insignia.
