Honor Code and Personal Commitment for CYT Students

- I have read the student handbook. I understand fully the concept of the tutorial and agree to support the stated principles.

I understand that CYT has a zero tolerance policy regarding these issues and by failing to adhere to these policies, I may insure my dismissal from CYT classes. I will not only practice abstinence, but will also keep my conversation clean and healthy regarding these topics.

Policy of Disciplinary Action
