### PRESENT LANGUAGE

8 SECTION 3. NATIONAL ALUMNI RELATIONS  
9 AND INTERNAL VOLUNTEER DEVELOPMENT  
10 COMMITTEE. The National Alumni Relations and  
11 Internal Volunteer Development Committee shall  
12 consist of ~~the National Alumni Relations/Internal~~  
13 ~~Volunteer Development Director as Chair~~, one alumni  
14 Member from each region and other Members as  
15 deemed necessary.

17 The National Alumni Relations and Internal Volunteer  
18 Development Committee Member from each region  
19 shall be nominated by the National Alumni Relations  
20 and Internal Volunteer Development ~~Director~~ and  
21 appointed by the National President.

23 It shall be the duty of the National Alumni Relations and  
24 Internal Volunteer Development Committee to  
25 coordinate all alumni affairs of the Fraternity, to  
26 promote continued alumni interest in the Fraternity's  
27 ideals and programs, and to serve as the governing body  
28 of the Fraternity's alumni. It also shall be the duty of the  
29 National Alumni Relations and Internal Volunteer  
30 Development Committee to initiate and coordinate  
31 identification, recruitment, development, retention and  
32 recognition programs for volunteers to work within and  
33 for the Fraternity.

38 PURPOSE: The National Alumni Relations and Internal Volunteer Development Director shall be removed from the  
39 Program Director Position and placed as an appointed chair of the National Alumni Relations and Internal Volunteer  
40 Development Committee, a standing committee of the National Fraternity.

42 RATIONALE: Though the Alumni Relations and Internal Volunteer Development Committee and Director are extremely  
43 important positions, they should be considered as a standing committee and should not be listed as a program director.  
44 Though the function of this committee is of necessary importance, it does not directly affect the direction in which the  
45 National Fraternity's vision and mission statement should be carried out through the Fraternity's program Director

### PROPOSED LANGUAGE

SECTION 3. NATIONAL ALUMNI RELATIONS  
AND INTERNAL VOLUNTEER DEVELOPMENT  
COMMITTEE. The National Alumni Relations and

consist of **a Chair appointed by the National  
President**, one alumni Member from each region and  
other Members as deemed necessary.

The National Alumni Relations and Internal Volunteer  
Development Committee Member from each region  
shall be nominated by the National Alumni Relations  
and Internal Volunteer Development **Chair** and  
appointed by the National President.

It shall be the duty of the National Alumni Relations and  
Internal Volunteer Development Committee to  
coordinate all alumni affairs of the Fraternity, to  
promote continued alumni interest in the Fraternity's  
ideals and programs, and to serve as the governing body  
of the Fraternity's alumni. It also shall be the duty of the  
National Alumni Relations and Internal Volunteer

for the Fraternity.
