### PRESENT LANGUAGE

8 SECTION 6. NATIONAL SERVICE AND  
9 COMMUNICATION COMMITTEE. The National  
10 Service and  
11 Communication Committee shall consist of the National  
12 Service and Communication Director as Chair and  
13 Members nominated by the National Service and  
14 Communication Director and appointed by the National  
15 President.

17 It shall be the duty of the National Service and  
18 Communication Committee to develop a two-year  
19 National Service Program for consideration and action  
20 by the biennial National Convention; to stimulate  
21 effective and well-rounded service programs by  
22 instigating resource development and distribution; to  
23 encourage high-quality Chapter service programs  
24 through an effective program of promotion and  
25 recognition of Chapter service activities, opportunities  
26 and incentives; ~~and to coordinate the Fraternity's youth~~  
27 ~~service activities, including those related to scouting~~

53 partner organizations the Scouting and Youth Services Director would become a permanent Program Director position.  
54 The Service and Communications Committee and the Scouting and Youth Services Committee will serve similar but
