



Requirements of Local Association and Bowling Establishment

For Hosting The Annual Championship Tournament

Of The District # 1 600 Club

1. The local association should have available at least one (1) bowling establishment with **16 lanes**. The entire house must be available to the District # 1 600 Club on the third (3rd) weekend of October for squad times to be determined by the proprietor and the Secretary of the District # 1 600 Club.
2. Letters of intent to host the District # 1 600 Club Tournament must be submitted by **BOTH** the local 600 Club and the bowling establishment, to the Board of Directors of the District # 1 600 Club by **September 30th** prior to the year to host said tournament, in order that the Board may submit the bid to the membership at the annual meeting. In the event that no bid is received for a given year, the Board of Directors of the District # 1 600 Club will be given the authority to enlist a bid from a local 600 Club** and bowling establishment meeting the requirements.
3. The bowling establishment agrees to provide **USBC** approved lane conditions for all squads of the tournament.
4. The bowling establishment must have available a meeting room spacious enough to accommodate 75-100 people for a business meeting.
5. The bowling establishment will furnish **two (2)** trophies suitably engraved for presentation to the winners of **(1) High Actual Series (2) and High Handicap Series**.
6. The local 600 Club must furnish lane monitors as necessary to run the Tournament and any other office help as may be required by the District # 1 Board of Directors.
7. The local 600 Club will be responsible for running a 50/50 raffle during each squad with proceeds split equally between the District # 1 600 Club and the Local Club.

8. The local 600 Club must include with their bid, a copy of a map showing the location of the Tournament House.
9. With the District # 1 600 Club Board of Directors, as advisors, the local 600 Club will be responsible for the preparation of a reception to follow the District # 1 600 Tournament. The local 600 Club will pay any expenses incurred.

****NOTE****

The local 600 Club mentioned above may be an established 600 Club from associations, which have formed a club or may be a combined group of interested 600 members from an association, which does not have a formal 600 Club.
