Hosting Center Requirements for District # 6 – 600 Club Annual Tournament

- 1) To be considered for hosting the District # 6 – 600 Club's Annual Tournament, there must be at least one 10-lane establishment, with all lanes available for all scheduled tournament shifts.
- 2) To suitably decorate their establishment for the duration of the tournament and to keep establishment in a state of cleanliness at all times.
- 3) To maintain lanes and machines in best possible working conditions throughout the tournament. Approaches should be cleaned between each shift. Additional lane conditioning/dressing need not be applied between shifts, but must be applied prior to the start of the first squad of each day of the tournament.
- 4) To display the American Flag for the duration of the tournament. Provide a copy of the National Anthem at the beginning of each squad.
- 5) To provide foul judges if foul detecting devices fail.
- 6) To provide adequate enclosed offices for the use of the tournament manager and her staff, and provide adequate space and tables for the sale items. To also provide additional tables and/or arrangements as may be required of the tournament manager.
- 7) To provide a Trophy to the winner of the tournament. The trophy must include the following words or phrases: "District # 6 – 600 Club" "Date of Tournament" "Champion".
- 8) To provide a suitable location for the standings board for the duration of the tournament.
- 9) To provide a suitable location for the bid letters and Sanction application to be posted for membership view.
- 10) To provide a public address system to be used at the tournament manager's discretion.
- 11) To provide assurance of ample liability insurance to cover bowlers, tournament manager, and assistants in case of accidents on premises.
- 12) To cooperate with the District # 6 – 600 Club Board of Directors and to maintain orderly conduct of spectators, etc.
- 13) Lanes shall be available to be inspected for proper conditioning by the Local Association or other ruling body upon the bowling of an award score.
- 14) To advance monies to the scorekeepers/monitors at the current District # 6 – 600 Club rate.
- 15) Lanes will be paid actual lineage used and/or scorekeeper/monitor reimbursement as requested by lanes manager/proprietor – i.e., daily or at the conclusion of the tournament. The District # 6 - 600 Club's preference is to pay with one check at the conclusion of the tournament.
