

## *District # 6 - 600 Club*

### **Hosting Association/Club Requirements for District #6 – 600 Club Annual Tournament**

- 1) To be considered for hosting the District # 6 – 600 Club's Annual Tournament, there must be at least one 10-lane establishment, with all lanes available for all scheduled tournament shifts.
- 2) Host a buffet following the final squad of the tournament, prior to Annual meeting. This buffet should accommodate approximately 30 people, not necessarily held at the center. The Annual meeting to be held at the same location as the buffet.
- 3) Provide and schedule scorekeepers when manual scorekeeping is required. Scorekeepers are paid \$2.00 per pair of lanes per shift. If automatic scoring devices are used, monitors must be furnished. Each monitor will be paid at the rate of \$2.00 per six lanes per shift.
- 4) Collect, determine and disburse jackpot monies. Schedule of bowlers will be furnished. District #6 – 600 Club Executive Board member will be appointed to oversee Jackpot as needed.
- 5) Assist in tournament office as needed or requested.
- 6) Arrange for lanes to be inspected within 30 days after an honor score is rolled.
- 7) Provide map with locations of lanes and hotel/motels to Club Secretary/Treasurer by at time of June meeting. Include address and telephone numbers of same.
- 8) Hosting Associations or Clubs may not hold fund raising activities which are in direct competition with District # 6 – 600 Club, i.e., 50/50, sale table items, pins, etc.
- 9) Request from Chamber of Commerce to provide brochures with points of interest in your area to be displayed in tournament office, or other suitable location.
