2009 REFUND POLICY

- ✓ **REGISTRATION FEES:** are **non-refundable**
- ✓ **CLOTHING/UNIFORMS:** There are **NO REFUNDS** on clothing or uniforms
 - If YOU order wrong size, there will be a restocking fee
 - If WE make an error, there is NO FEE
- ✓ **INSTRUCTION/COMPETITION FEES:**
IF YOU PAY IN FULL AT REGISTRATION:
 - Instruction/competition fees are 100% refundable until May 14, 2009
 - Instruction/competition fees are 50% refundable May 15, 2009 through June 15, 2009
 - After June 15, there will be **NO REFUNDS** on instruction/competition fees
 - No refunds will be given to anyone dismissed from the program due to a policy violation
- ✓ **PAYMENT DUE DATES:** (If you did not pay all enrollment fees at registration)
 - 6/2/09: 2nd payment due

Hair

- ✓ **Rec., Juniors & All-Stars:** Hair should be parted on the dancer's right side, smoothed over, and put in low bun with purchased matching hairpiece put around it. Please secure any bangs or "wispies" back with bobby pins and hairspray. If your team is wearing a headband you should secure it in the back with bobby pins (criss-cross them to prevent them from falling out during the performance).
