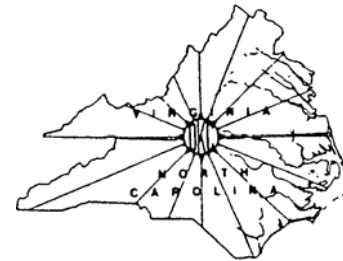

- A Preliminary Confirmation will be sent to the e-mail address on the AKC entry form after your entry has been processed. Please review the information in the confirmation for input errors and notify the Trial Secretary of any corrections.
- Final confirmations of entry and judging schedule will be sent to the e-mail address on the AKC form after the closing date.

NOTE: If the exhibitor has not received the Final confirmation within five days of the trial, contact the Trial Secretary.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- Type or **PRINT** neatly
- Entry fees are \$20 for the 1st entry of a dog (includes \$3 AKC recording fee) and \$10 for each additional entry of same dog/ SAME DAY.
- Make checks payable to **Danville Kennel Club, Inc.** and mail to Trial Secretary at the PO Box address.
- Be sure to include the correct fees. Overpayments less than \$10 will not be refunded.
- Entries **open** Wednesday, Sept. 28, 2005 at 7^{AM} and will be accepted on a first received basis.
- Entries **close** Monday, Nov. 14, 2005 at 5^{PM} or when limits have been reached.
- All entries must be submitted on official AKC agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of front & back will be accepted only if legible and official AKC size.
- Entries will not be accepted without signature, back of entry form with agreement, and fees, nor will telephone or FAX entries will be accepted.
- Owners are responsible for ensuring that entry forms are completed IN FULL. Entries submitted without ALL information will be returned as invalid.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A \$20.00 service fee will be added for all returned checks.
- If you use a delivery service, you MUST check the "**NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED**" box, as the Trial Secretary will not be present to sign for your entries.

INVALID ENTRIES

Invalid entries will be returned to the address on the entry form. The following constitute an invalid entry:

- An entry which is missing any AKC required information
- Entries not on Official AKC forms OR on a photocopy of an AKC form without the current agreement and rule on the reverse side or attached to the entry form
- Entries which are illegible, or incomplete
- Entries received with insufficient fees
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, e-mail, telephone, FAX, or telegraph entries cannot be accepted.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with a bitch entered, which is in season on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$10 (each day), upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the trial secretary no later than 8 AM on the date of the trial.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No classes will be held up by a late exhibitor.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. No dogs may be left tied to trees, cars, fences, etc.

Dogs under 6 months of age are not allowed at this trial.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 12 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have an AKC limited registration, or are of a registerable breed that have obtained an ILP number from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

RIBBONS AND AWARDS

Rosettes and a dog related toy or treats will be awarded to the first through fourth place dog in each jump height division in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. New title ribbons will be given to those earning a title at our trial. MACH Rosettes and a MACH bar will be given to exhibitors earning a MACH title at this trial.

All ribbons and prizes must be claimed the day of the Trial; none will be mailed.

CLASSES OFFERED

All regular and preferred Standard and JWW will be offered on Saturday and Sunday. Please consult AKC rules and regulations pertaining to Agility Trials for complete description and eligibility for entry in these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class/division.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All height divisions will be offered in both the standard classes and the jumpers with weaves classes. PLEASE SEND A PHOTOCOPY OF YOUR JUMP HEIGHT CARD. DOGS WITH NO CARD MUST BE MEASURED PRIOR TO

OBSTACLES

All obstacles and equipment used at this trial meet the requirements for agility trials.

NOVICE CONTACT FAMILIARIZATION

There will be equipment familiarization for Novice exhibitors on both Saturday and Sunday.

DIRECTIONS

From the East: Take Rt. 58 towards Danville. Exit onto 29 South/Danville Expressway Bypass. Exit onto Rt. 86 South (this will be a left hand turn at the end of the ramp). Go approx. ½ miles and turn right onto Shady Grove Rd (before the used car lot). Go approx. 3 miles and turn left onto Gammon Rd (across from the tall green chain link fence). Go approx. 1 mile and Averett's driveway will be a black top road on the left at the end of the white fence.

From the North: Take Rt. 29 South. Follow the 29 South/Danville Expressway Bypass to Rt. 86 then follow the directions from the East.

From the West: Follow Rt. 58 towards Danville. There is a new bypass-you will not enter the city limits of Danville. Exit to the right onto 58 East Greensboro/South Boston (NOT Business 58). After approx. 5 miles, Exit Right onto Rt. 29 South to Greensboro. Take the first exit with the Welcome Center, Rt. 700. Turn left at the top of the ramp. Go approx. 2.5 miles and turn Right onto Gammon Rd (across from the tall, green chain link fence). Averett's driveway will be approx. 1 mile on the left.

From the South: From Route 29 going North exit onto St. Rt. 700/Shady Grove Rd (this is the exit with the NC Welcome Center). Turn right at the end of the exit ramp. Go approx. 5 miles and turn right onto Gammon Rd. The Equestrian Center will be approx. one mile on the left.
