## The Rambl in' Redneck



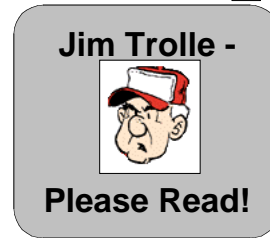
