

# Energy Efficiency Program For Low-Income Homeowners with Electric Heat

## Who?

- The Low-Income Energy Efficiency Program is offered to homeowners living on lower incomes, and who heat primarily with electricity.
- All types of residences are welcome to apply (mobile homes, semi-detached, single family homes, etc.)

## Where?

- The Low-Income Energy Efficiency Program is available to homeowners across Nova Scotia.

## What?

- The program offers energy audits and upgrades such as insulation in attics, walls, crawlspaces; caulking to seal off drafts and efficient lighting.

## Why?

- Most people living on low incomes are not able to pay for energy efficient upgrades, yet they would benefit from having their energy consumption reduced.
- There is also an environmental benefit from using less energy. Reduced demand for electricity means avoided costs for building new power generation.
