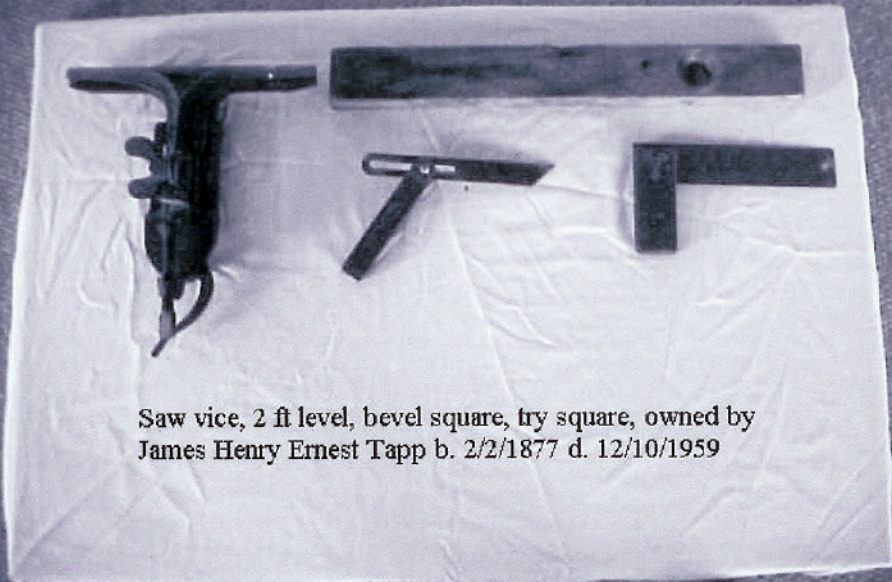

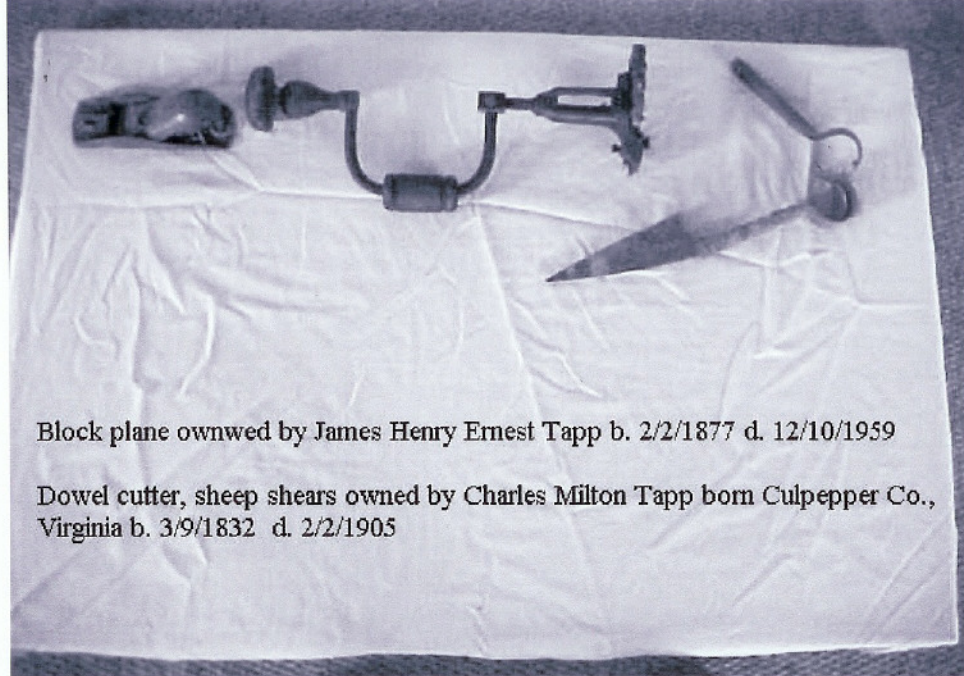

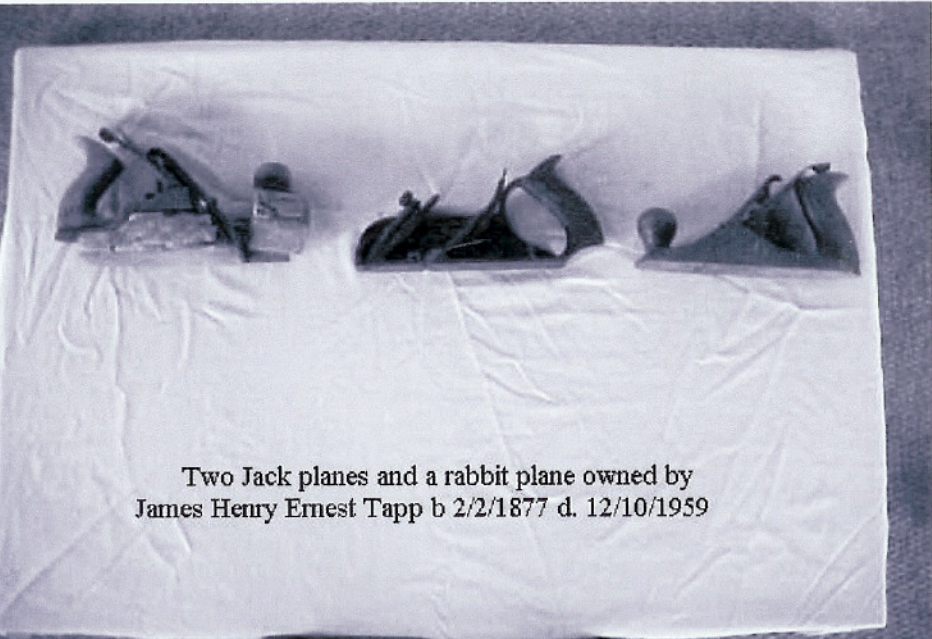

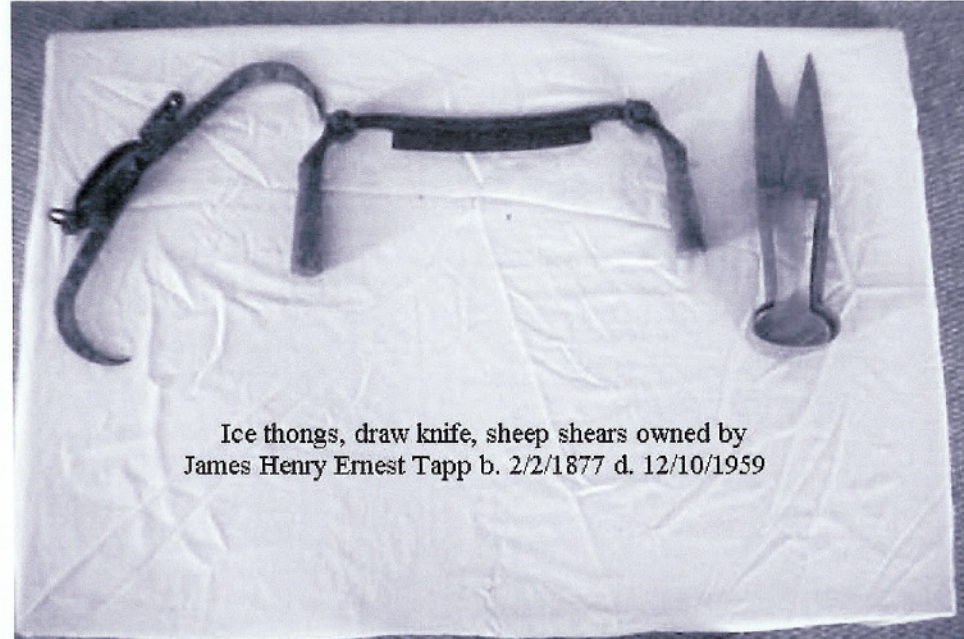


Block plane owned by James Henry Ernest Tapp b. 2/2/1877 d. 12/10/1959

Dowel cutter, sheep shears owned by Charles Milton Tapp born Culpepper Co., Virginia b. 3/9/1832 d. 2/2/1905



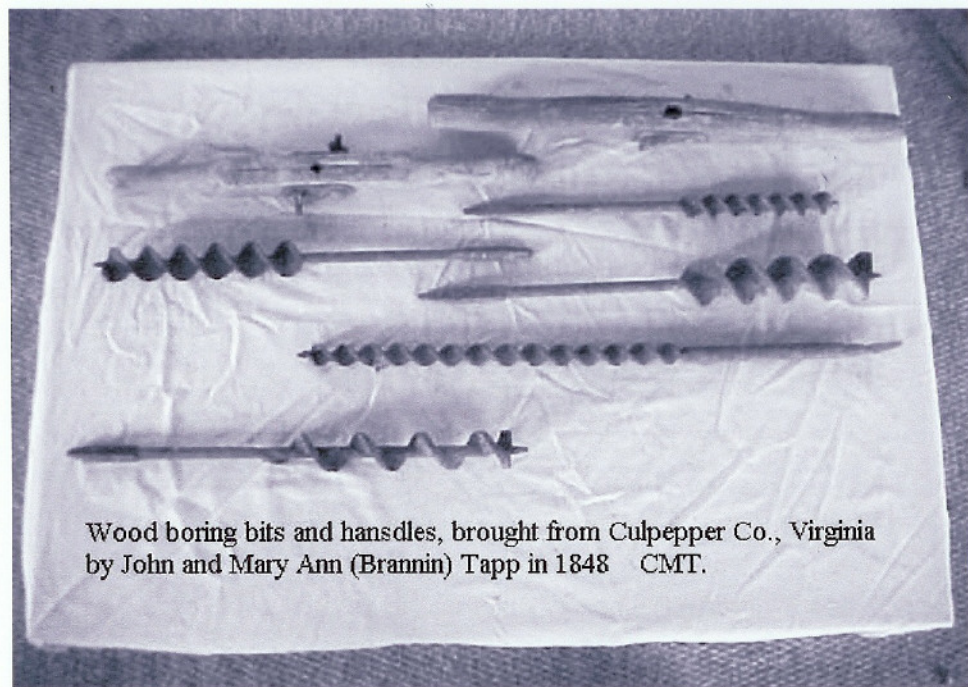
Two Jack planes and a rabbit plane owned by James Henry Ernest Tapp b 2/2/1877 d. 12/10/1959



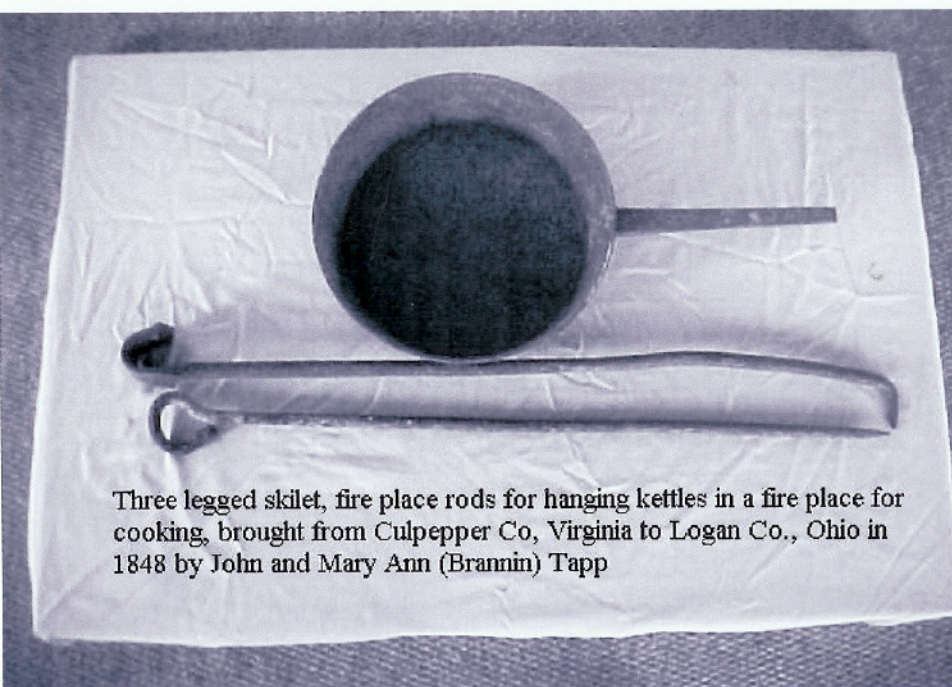

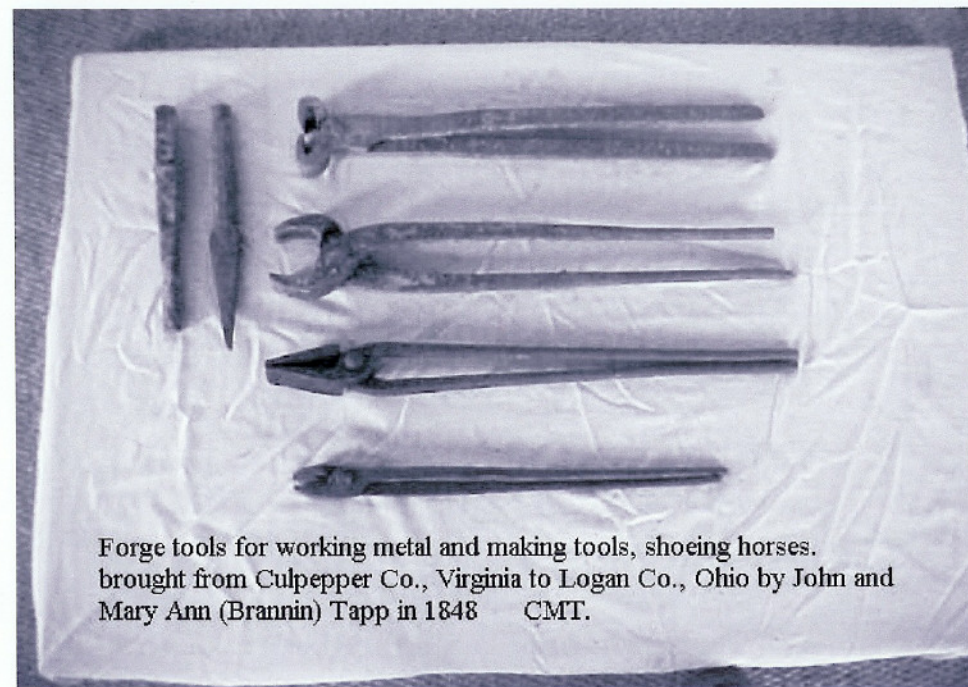

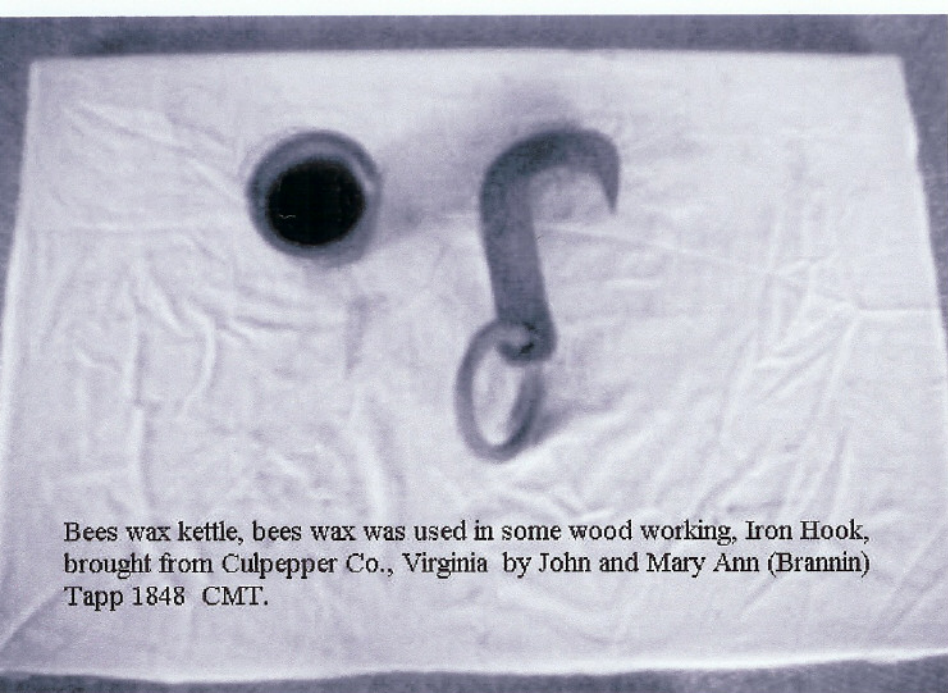

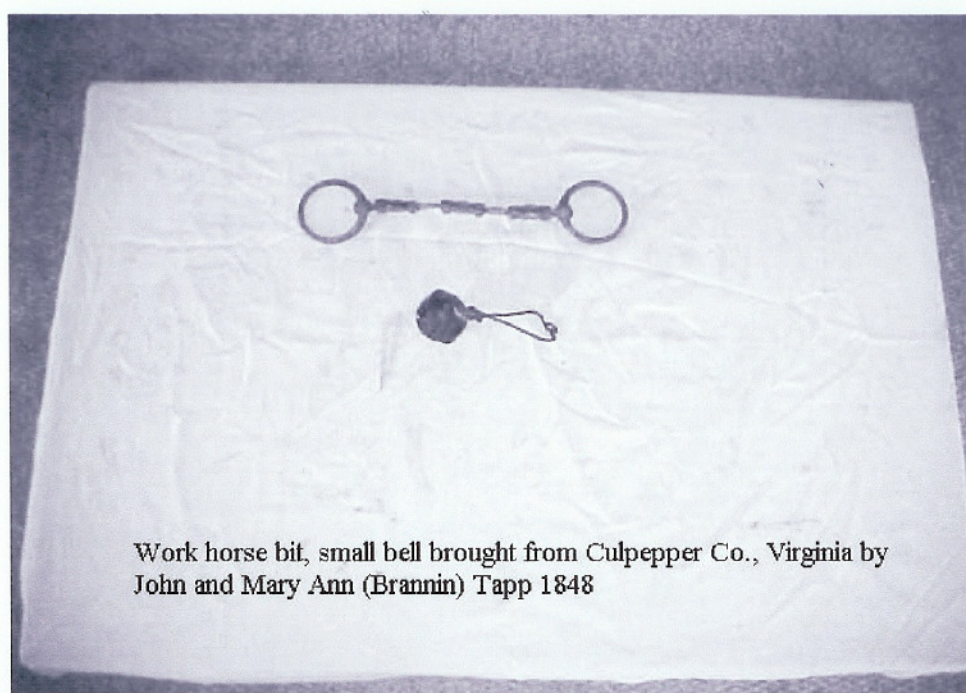

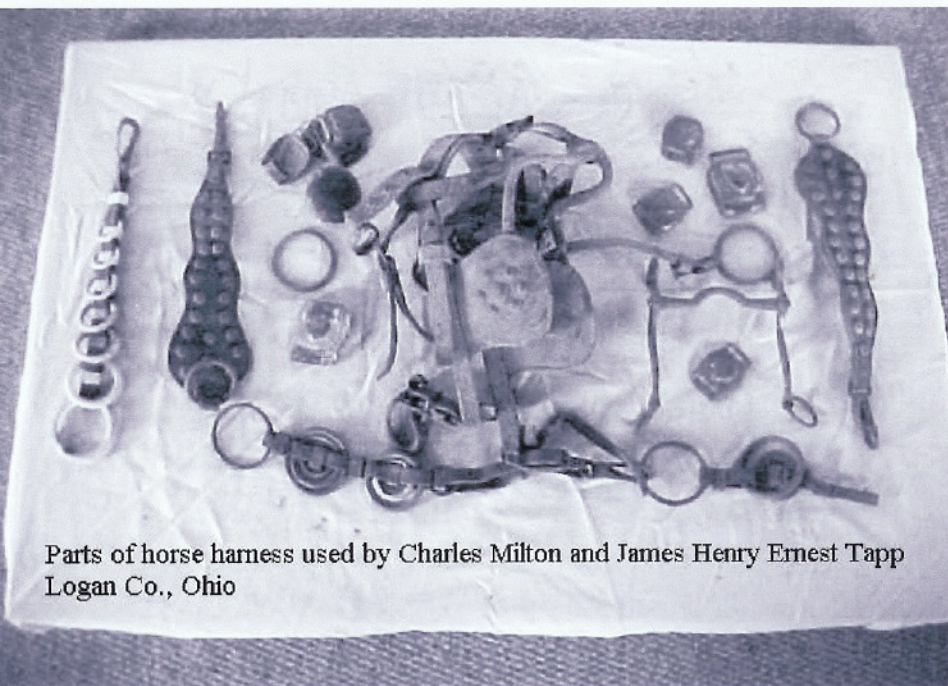

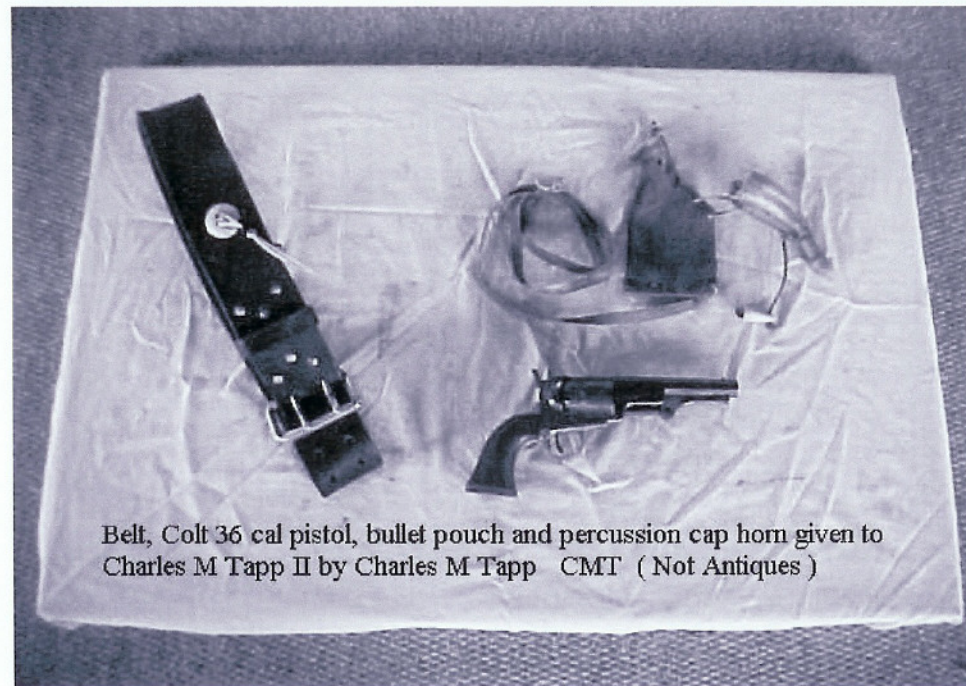
