

Use Unitedstreaming™ Videos on Your iPod

What you need:


- **5th Generation iPod** (the one that supports video)
- **iPod AV cable** (to connect to a TV or projector) *\$19.99 from the Apple Store*
- **Quicktime Pro** (Version 7 or later) *\$29.99 from the Apple Store*
- **iTunes 6** or later

STEP 1: Download the Video from Unitedstreaming™

1. Log on to Unitedstreaming™.
2. Use Search to locate the video you want to download.
3. At the bottom of the page, locate the Media Settings.

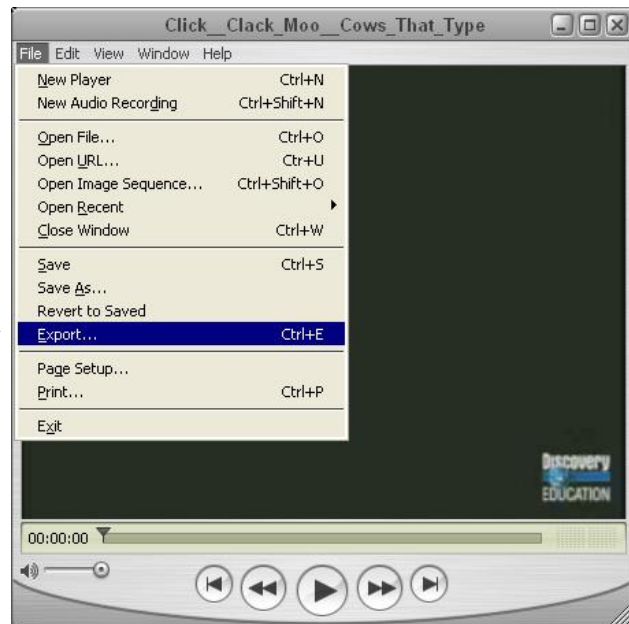

4. Make sure the “Quicktime” video format is selected.
5. Click on the download button  to download the video and save it on your computer.
6. Exit Unitedstreaming™.

STEP 2: Convert the Video to iPod format

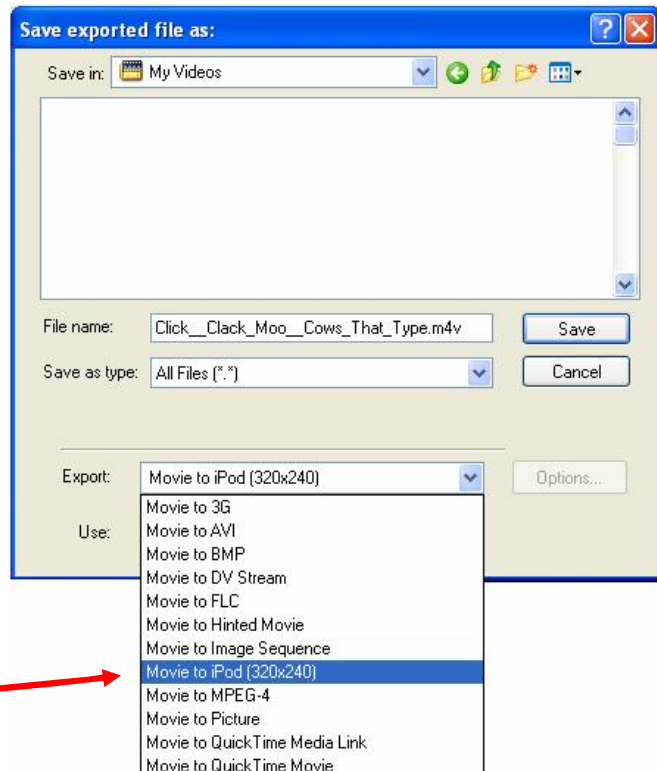
1. Open the folder where you saved the Quicktime video.
2. Double-click your video to open it. It should open with the Quicktime player.
3. Go to **File** and select **Export**.



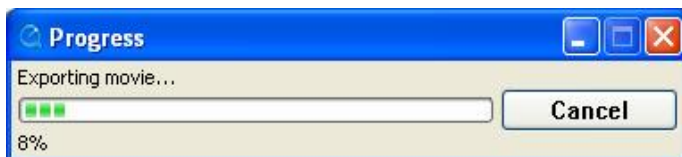
(If Export is grayed out, you will need to upgrade to Quicktime Pro.)

4. Select the video format for converting the clip.

Next to **Export**, select **Movie to iPod (320x240)**



NOTE: Depending on the speed of your computer, the conversion process can take a while – typically two or sometimes three times the running time of the video - so go get a snack or something while you wait.

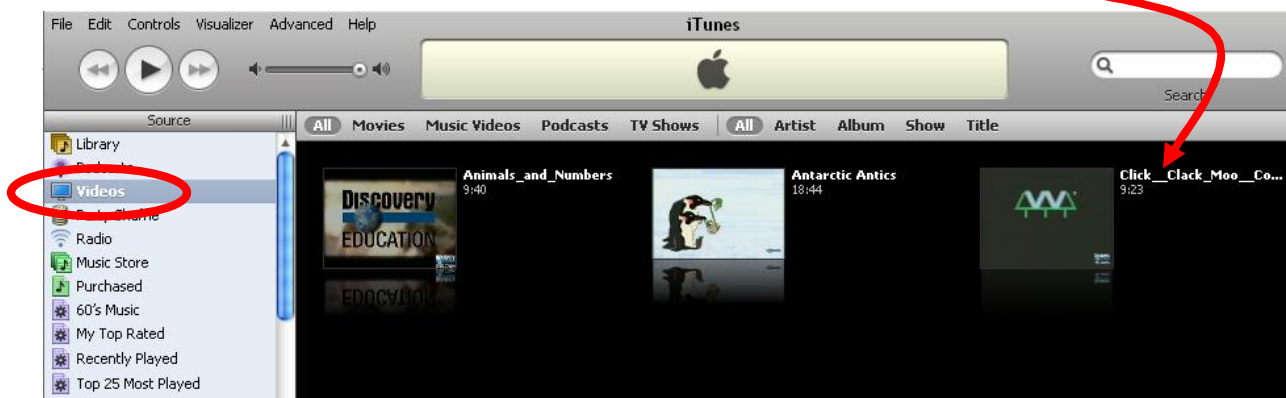


You'll be staring at this for a while, so make yourself comfortable.

When the export process is finished, you will have a video in a format that will play on your iPod.

STEP 3: Add Your Video to iTunes 6

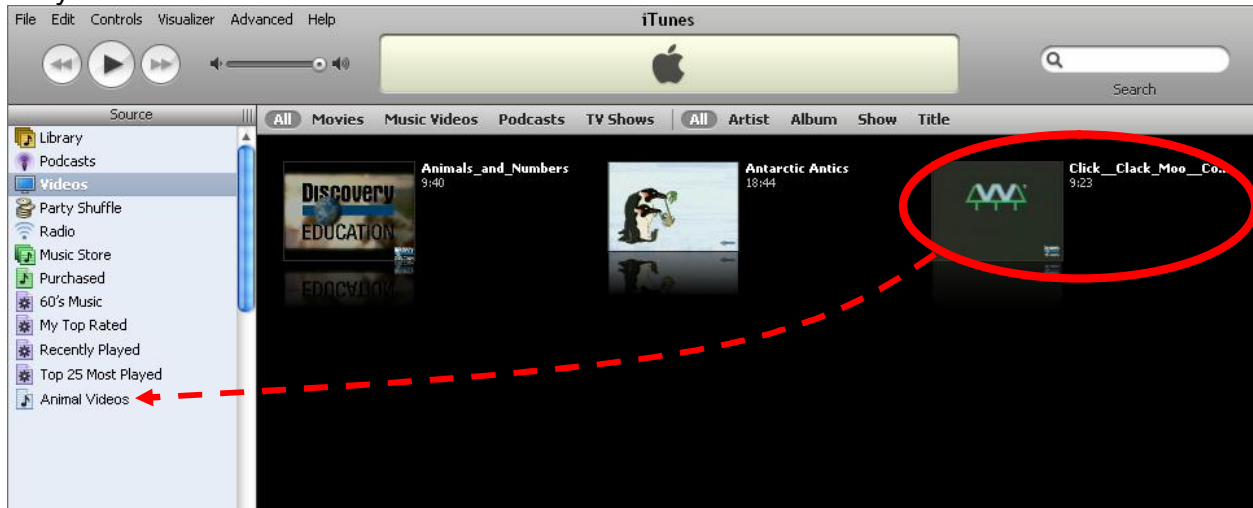
1. Open **iTunes**.
2. Go to the **File** menu and select **Add File to Library**.
3. Locate and **Open** the video you just converted.
4. Click on **Videos**. Your video should appear in the window.



- You can create a new video playlist just like you create a music playlist. Click on the plus symbol (+) at the bottom of the screen. Give your playlist a name.



- Add videos to your playlist by dragging them from the video window to the playlist you created.



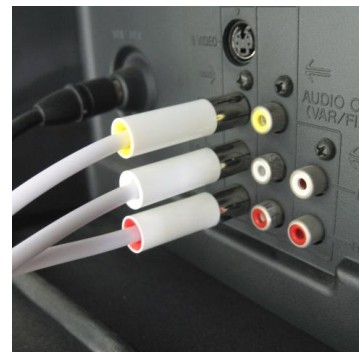
- When you connect your iPod to the computer the videos and the new playlist you created will be copied to your iPod when it updates.

STEP 4: Connect Your iPod to a TV and Play Your Video

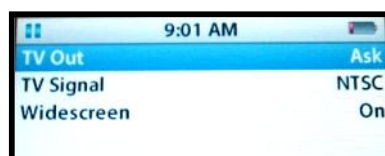
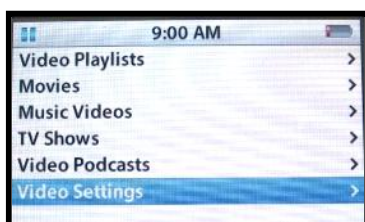
- Plug the iPod AV Cable into the headphone jack of the iPod.



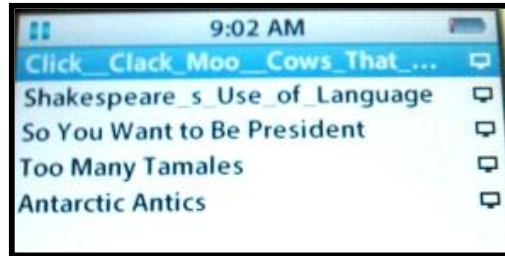
- Connect the video and audio cables to the video and audio inputs on your TV. Make sure your TV is set to the proper video input. (i.e. Video 1, Video 2, AUX)



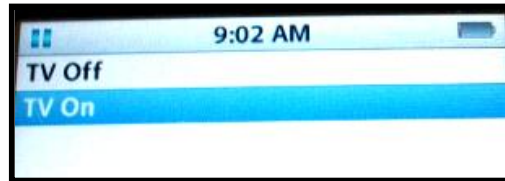
- Set your iPod to play video on a TV. Click on **Videos**. Click **Video Settings**, and then set **TV Out** to **Ask**.



4. Find the video playlist you created.
Click on the video you want to play.



5. Select **TV On** to play the video on the TV.



6. The video you selected will play on your TV Screen. You will not see the video play on your iPod. The screen will look like this.
