- Slide 2: Description of your pet organ (location, weight, size, system it is part of)
- Slides 3: Description of your pet organ's functions
- Slide 4: Explanation of what your pet organ does to keep you healthy
- Slide 5: Explanation of what you can do to keep your pet organ healthy
- Slide 6: Advertising slogan for your pet organ
- Slide 7: List of references
