


Make a Slide Show with Picasa™

NOTE: This help sheet assumes you already understand the process of copying your digital pictures from your digital camera to your computer.


Procedure #1 – Quick & Dirty

1. Open Picasa 

2. Select the folder of pictures that you want to show. →

3. Click on the picture where you want the slide show to start. →

4. Click the Slideshow button. →



5. A full screen slide show will begin.

If you move your mouse down to the bottom of the screen, the slide show control bar will appear.



This ends the slide show.

Move one slide backward

Play/Pause the slide show


Move one slide forward

Set the time each slide is on the screen

Procedure #2 – Be Selective

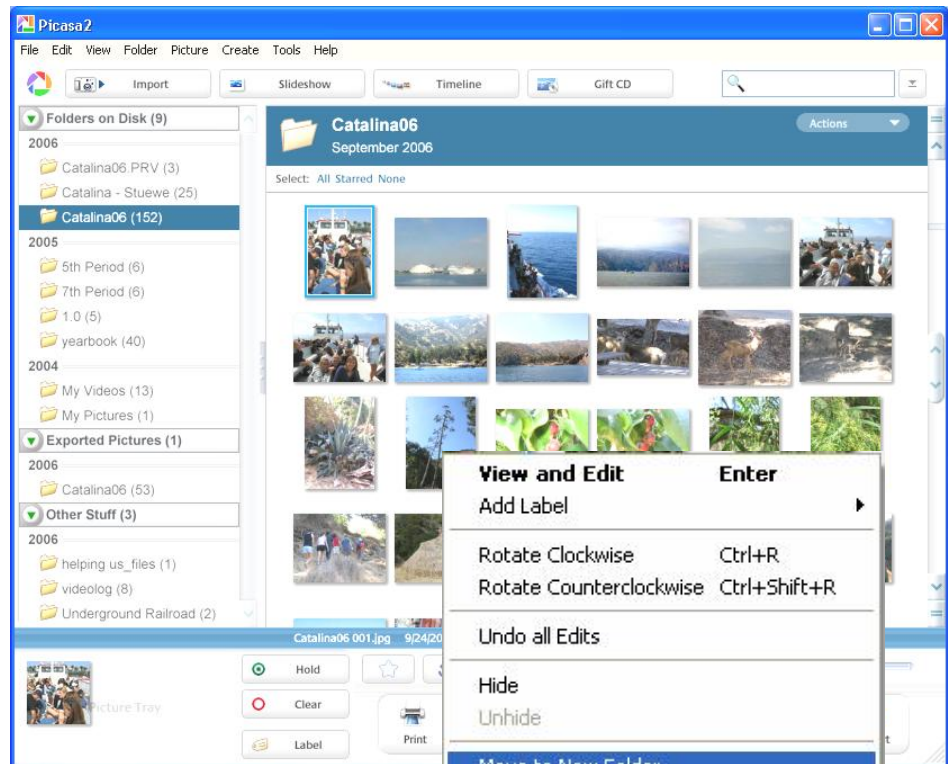
Maybe you only want to include certain pictures in your slide show.

1. Open Picasa

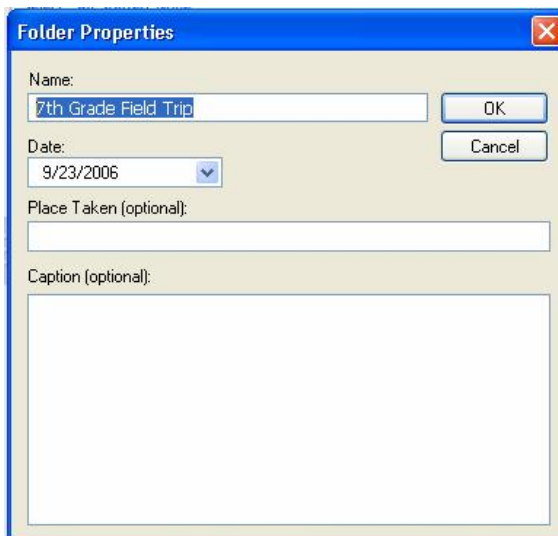
2. While you hold down the



key, click on some of the pictures you want to include in your slide show.

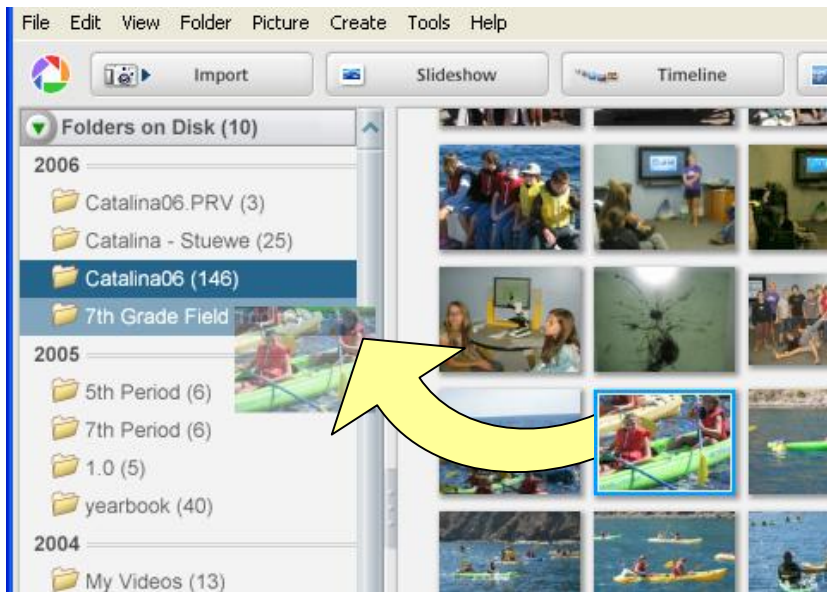


3. When you have a few selected, right-click on one of your selected pictures and select **“Move to a New Folder”**.



4. Type a name for the new folder that contains your slide show pictures and click OK.

5. Moving more photos to that folder is just a matter of clicking and dragging.



Click and drag the pictures on top of the New Folder you just created.

6. Once you have moved all the pictures you want to include in the slide show, now you can put them in the correct order. Time for some more clicking and dragging.



Click on your slide show folder.

Click and drag a picture to move it.

7. When all your pictures are in the correct order, run your slide show by clicking the Slideshow button.
