



## **Elective rotation in Laser**

**Introduction:** Laser technology is one of the versatile equipment in dermatology. The ability to understand the basics and clinical applications will help the dermatologist to assess which cases that may benefit from such treatment. Although we have only limited number of laser in our center, exposure to the laser will give basic about this technology and the ability to assess and give opinion for such treatment.

### **Objectives:**

- 1-Exposure to cases that need to be assessed and treated by Q-switched lasers
- 2-Understand the essential basic science of laser used in dermatology.
- 3-The rotation period is 1-month duration. The rotating physician will attend 2 laser clinics per week for the whole rotation (Saturday and Monday). If one of these clinics cancelled (coincide with a holiday) it will be replaced with one of the Wednesday laser clinics.
- 4-Treat at least 40 Cases, (Log book need to be signed)
- 5-The rotating physician maybe asked to participate in some of the studies that are done at the clinic.

### **Period of rotation:**

January, May, October of each year. These rotations will be postponed whenever there is shortage of manpower in the our center.

### **Evaluation:**

The rotating physician will be evaluated at the mid and the end of the rotation and the report will be singed and a copy of it will be given to Dr Qasem Al Saleh

### **Feedback:**

The rotating physician will be asked kindly to give his written feedback in a prepared form to help to improve the rotation.

The Rotation will be announced 1-2 months in advance and the application are reviewed by the following:
