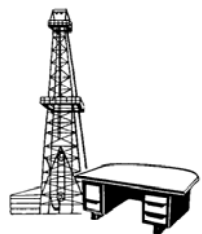

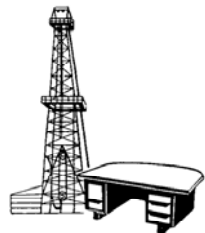

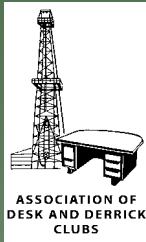

In accordance with Article XXV-Amendments, Section 1, (a)-“...the proposed amendments are submitted in writing to the Chairman of the Rules Committee by an Association Officer, the Board of Directors, the Rules Committee, or a club prior to a deadline date set by the Board of Directors, such date not to be less than ninety (90) days prior to convention, and...”

A deadline date, postmarked, faxed, or emailed no later than Thursday, February 12, 2009 has been set for submitting proposed amendments to the ADDC Bylaws and/or Standing Rules to the Rules Committee for presentation to the delegates at the 2009 ADDC Convention.

If your club wishes to propose a change, please be sure to include your phone, fax number, or email address in your correspondence. If you or your club wishes to discuss the proposals before they are submitted, please feel free to call or email me.

It is very important to state the Article number or Standing Rule number as it **now reads**, and then state the wording you are proposing.

Please send your proposed amendments to the ADDC Bylaw and/or Standing Rules to me at the above address or email me at grcabilene@midlandmap.com.

NOTE: Be sure to follow up after sending the proposed amendment (s) with either an email or phone call to be sure that I have received them.
