assumptions (EX 146)	Values in cells that you can change to determine new values for formulas.	I have no idea.
Office Clipboard (EX 157)	Special place in the computers memory that allows you to collect text and graphic items.	I used this in Word.
drag and drop (EX 159)	Using the mouse to move or copy cells.	I have used this in Word.
#REF! (EX 162)	Error indicating cell reference error	I have seen this when I screw up a formula.
freeze the titles (EX 163)	When Excel displays the titles on the screen, no matter how far down to the right you scroll.	I have used this in a project.
date stamp (EX 165)	Shows the date a workbook, report, or other document was created or the period it represents.	I haven't used this before.
NOW function (EX 165)	One of the 14 date and time functions available in Excel.	I use this in a project.
absolute cell reference (EX 168)	Instructs Excel to keep the cell reference.	I used this in AYK
mixed cell reference (EX 168)	A cell reference with only one dollar sign before either the column or the row	I haven't used this before.

relative cell reference (EX 168)	Instructs Excel to adjust the cell reference as it copies it to the destination area.	I have only used this in projects.
IF function (EX 171)	Useful when you want to assign a value to a cell based on a logical test.	I have used this in projects.
nested IF function (EX 176)	the action to be taken for the true or false case includes yet another IF function.	I have not used this before.
Drawing toolbar (EX 181)	Provides tools.	I haven't used this before.
floating toolbar (EX 182)	Displayed in its own window and can be moved anywhere in the Excel window.	I have used this in Word.
toolbar dock (EX 182)	If you drag the toolbar close to the edge of the window, Excel positions the toolbar here.	I have used this in Word.
category names (EX 187)	Ranges to chart nonadjacent ranges.	I haven't used this before.
chart sheet (EX 187)	Pie chart resides on a separate sheet.	I have used this on projects.
data series (EX 187)	Contains data that determines the size of the slices in the pie.	I haven't used this before.
exploded Pie chart (EX 187)	A Pie chart with one or more slices offset.	I haven't used this before.
Pie chart (EX 187)	Used to show the relationship or proportion of parts to whole.	I have used this before.
offsetting (EX 194)	Exploding	I have no idea.
horizontal split bar (EX 204)	Going across the middle of the window.	I don't know what this is.
sensitivity analysis (EX 204)	Using Excel to scrutinize the impact of changing values in cells that are referenced by a formula in another cell.	I have never used this ever.
vertical split bar (EX 204)	Bar going up and down middle of the window.	I haven't used this before.
what-if analysis (EX 204)	Using Excel to scrutinize	I have not used this before.
