On September 14, 2006, Debra Huttner officially introduced her new organization, *A Time for Capers, Inc.* *Capers* is the inspiration of quadriplegic President and Founder, Miss Huttner, who discovered a means of expression through art. Her designs are featured on watches, which are now available for sale to the public.

When Miss Huttner was a child of six she was hit by a car, necessitating the use of a wheelchair for mobility. Miss Huttner considers herself a “handicapable” designer whose humor and active lifestyle inspire her to create art. Since her accident, Debra has created hundreds of works of art by utilizing technology, such as computer programs.



A Time for Capers started over ten years ago, when Miss Huttner began creating cartoons on her computer. Now, she produces watches that incorporate some of her popular and religious themed designs.

“As a handicapable woman, I feel so proud and blessed for the opportunity to create both my art, and now my company,” says founder, Debra Huttner. “With *Capers*, I want to demonstrate that individuals with disabilities can be leaders in the workplace.”
