

Dear Florida College donors:

There is a rapidly growing number of FC alumni and donors who censure the unwarranted dismissals of Jaun Guyer (1999), Shane Scott (2001), and Fred Thompson (2002). Guyer was Director of Campus Facilities; Scott was a very popular teacher on the Bible faculty; Thompson was Director of Publications, and editor of the FC Magazine. **AND, we question** the administrative mis-management that has produced the multi-million dollar deficit over the past two school years.

The dismissals (a euphemism for “firings”) revolved around the personal annoyances of two men: Dr. Caldwell and Bill Hammontree, a board member. Alumni and donors need to know the truth about the unprofessional treatment of these three men who are our brothers in Christ — men who offered excellent business, academic, and professional skills to advance the college as a respected educational institution. **Their dismissals were handled quietly in hope that the college’s constituency would never learn about the unfair treatment they received.**
