Last Meetings Minutes:

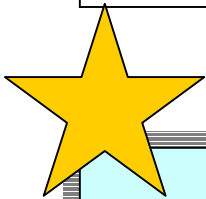
Group met in our normal club space for February Meeting.

I am very much against any additional airspace restrictions in this area. As it stands now it is almost impossible to get in and out of the airport at St. Marys. This is not in the best interest of GA and I feel GA is certainly no threat to this area.

We already have 3 Military bases within 50 miles of this area and the restrictions there are not nearly as obtrusive to normal flight plans. We DON'T NEED THIS TYPE OF RESTRICTION TO HAVE SAFE FLIGHT OPERATIONS IN THIS AREA.
