

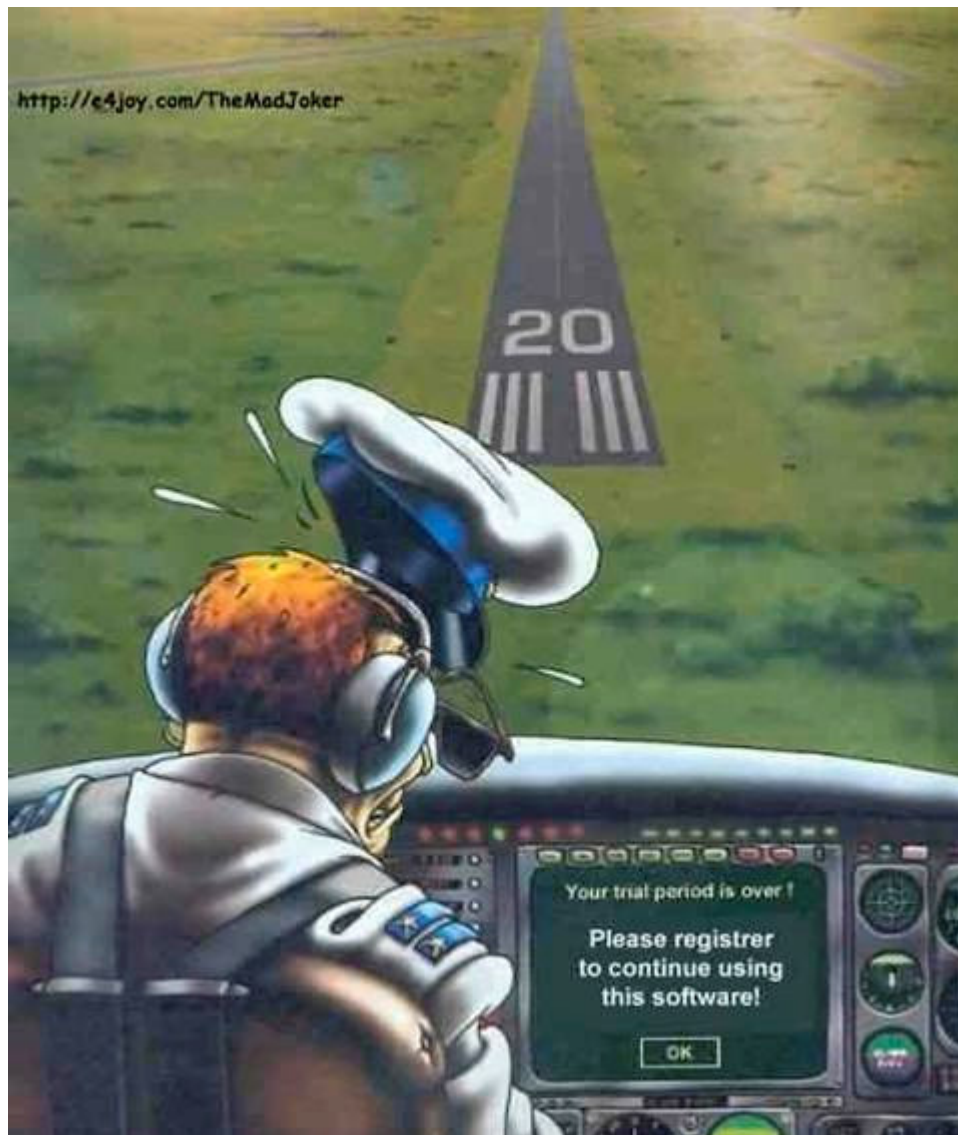

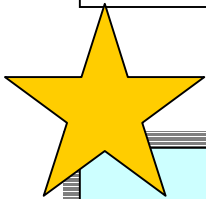
Last Meetings Minutes:
