Steve Suminski opened the meeting at 1930.

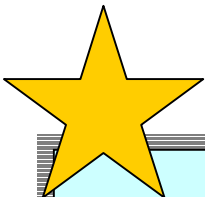
Our members all helped organize our new office space in Bld 880 at Cecil Field.

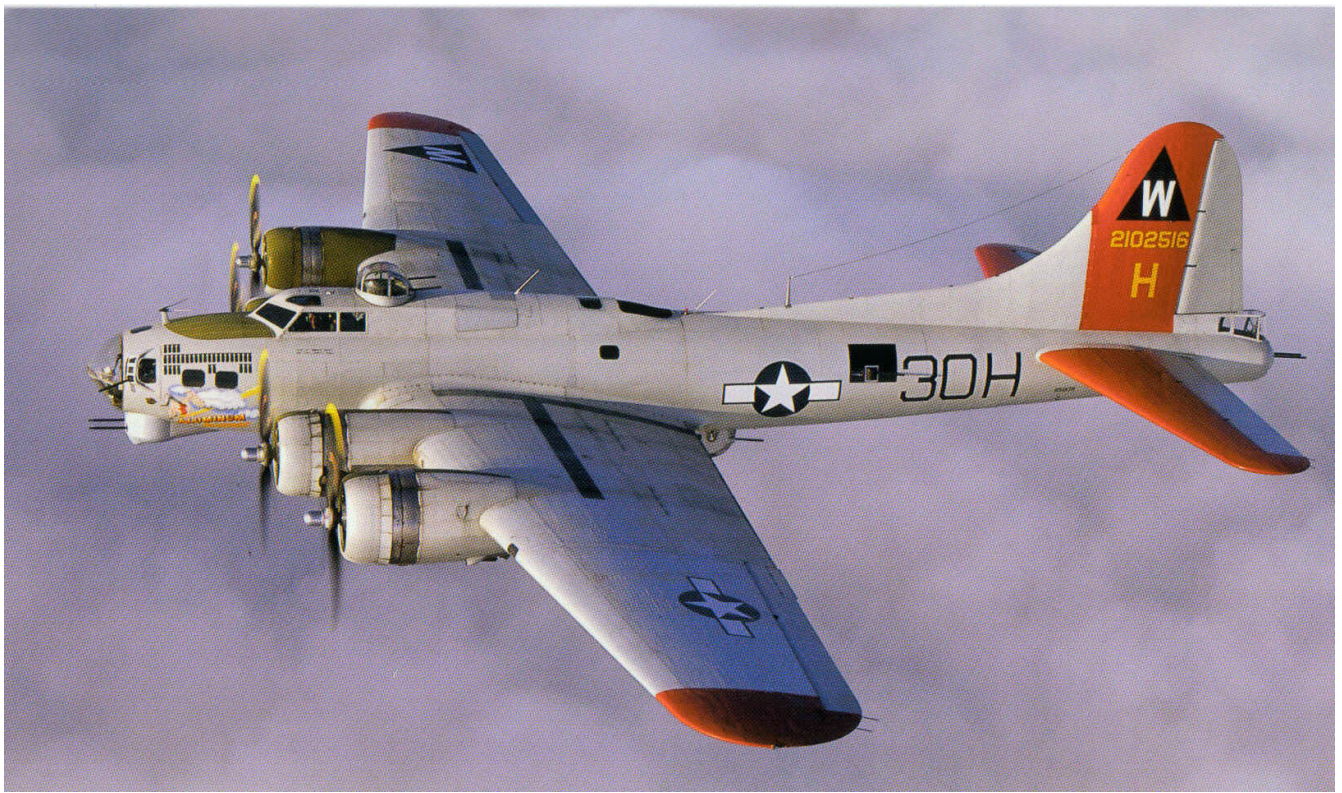
