All members were aware about the influence of land mafia's in surrounding area and occupying undemarcated land illegally by them. There was a recent survey conducted by the Govt of Uttaranchal for exploring the possibility of developing official/ residential complexes in Chandrabani area. Most of plots in the enclave area are still undemarcated and it is the matter of great concern as open area may invite attention of the Govt. agencies for acquisition of the society land.

Following agenda items were discussed.

1. It was decided that all plot holders must demarcate their plots as early as possible. It was also suggested that each member construct a low cost (10X10 feet) structure with iron sheet roofing and one iron grilled door as store/out house, so the land looks like fully occupied plot. All members agreed on it and assured for early action in this regard.

One member Shri Subhash Chauhan who has recently joined the membership has started construction of boundary and small structure in his plot. All members requested to Mr. Chauhan to work out the tentative cost of such small low cost structure for the benefit of the members. The members can think of jointly awarding the work to reduce the individual costs of construction. Mr. Chauhan assured that he will provide the details as early as possible, and the details will be circulated to all members for further course of action.

2. It was also decided that society will soon request the Electricity Board, Uttaranchal for erecting the electric polls in the society area.

3. It was agreed that the society members will meet soon to review the action taken on the above agenda items.
