Note:

1. A 10-point scale is used for Average and Median scores.
2. The Average is the mean of all the scores in the staff member's evaluation.
3. The Median indicates the score found at the middle point when all the scores of all staff members evaluated at the same level are sorted in order of descending magnitude.
4. The Percentile indicates the position of the staff member, measured in percentage bands (i.e. 100 bands in descending order), when the Average scores of all staff members evaluated at the same level are sorted in order of descending magnitude.
5. The Standard Deviation is a way of measuring the extend to which a staff member's Average score differs from all the scores in the staff member's evaluation.
6. The Quartile indicates the position of the staff member measured in 4 bands, when the Average scores of all staff members evaluated at the same level are sorted in order of descending magnitude.
7. An evaluation with 10 or fewer respondents is not included in the computation of Percentile, Quartile and Ranking, and is denoted by 'N/A'.
