

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

## Short Paper: User Experience

The core principle behind user experience design is about creating a specific and customized user experience for each unique audience. User experience is about the audience's emotional experience while viewing and interacting with products or programs. Therefore, the most important part of a user experiencer designer's job is to ensure that the characteristics of a product or program create a high-quality experience that is customized for the audience. By keeping this key principle of user experience design in mind, designer's can make informed choices about the content to include in the website, making sure that the content will be interesting and enjoyable for the audience to read. Additionally, a core concept that is related to user experience design is about the connection between psychology and design. Therefore, designers can greatly enhance the user experience for the audience by incorporating their knowledge and understanding of how psychology and design are connected into the design process.

The next example I will discuss is about the importance of the principle of simplicity. By carefully considering this user experience design principle, designers can effectively emphasize the focal point of a design. I think the professionals at Google did an incredible job of creating a simple design for the Google website, even though this is one of the most complicated websites in existence. My first choice for a search engine to conduct research on is the Google website. The search engine is on the home page of the website. Immediately upon opening the home page, my attention is brought to the focal point. The search engine and Google logo are located in the center of the design, surrounded by plenty of negative space. Centering the search engine and Google logo, as well as surrounding these page elements with a significant amount of negative space, informs me that the page elements in this area of the design are the focal point. Additionally, the simple design of the home page helps me easily comprehend the purpose and message of the page. I think designers can significantly improve the

audience's user experience in the future by creating simple designs for detailed and intricate websites. In my last example, I will refer to the Google website also. I will be discussing the importance of designing a website that is fully functional, an essential user experience design concept. My user experience with the Google website has been excellent because my past experiences have proven that I can trust the many web services that Google offers to be reliable, consistent, and completely functional. As a result, I count on Google as an email service and search engine as part of my every day life. Therefore, creating a completely functional website that responds in the way the audience expects is necessary for gaining a long-term audience.
