This Week in Kindergarten...

We're into our plant unit...learning about the life cycle of plants as well as different plant parts and what they do. We're planting popcorn seeds (yes, popcorn does grow if you plant it! We are also investigating different seeds and how each kind is a little different from other plants.

We're continuing to read and write. I'm focusing in on using capital and lowercase letters in the appropriate places as well as using spaces and a punctuation mark at the end of each sentence.

In math, I have been focusing on addition and subtraction—learning the facts 0-10. We'll continue reviewing telling time, and recognizing numbers 0-100. (Remember, kids need to know all their numbers 0-50.)
