If you have content or layout suggestions, please forward them to me at the e-mail address splattered over numerous parts of this doc.

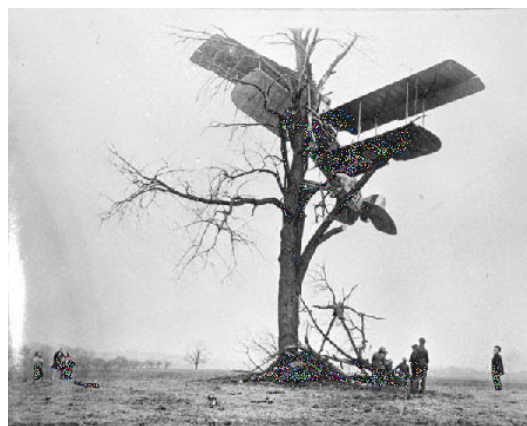

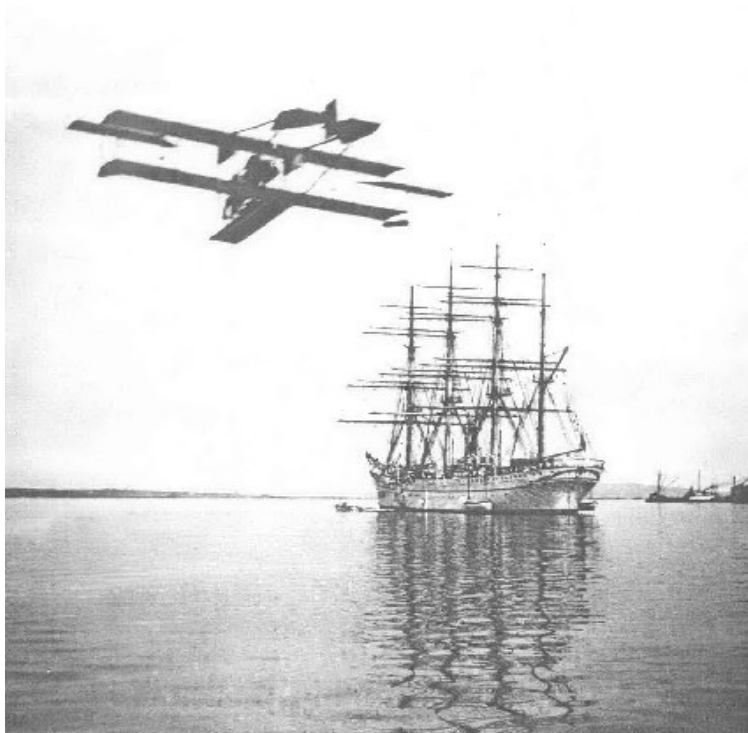
## President's Page

Contrary to conventional wisdom, I'm finding it –is- possible to have a life in addition to being an officer in the club, though I can see where the two-term limit is more for my protection, than the club's. I'm managing to get in a little flying in, both on behalf of Aqua-Terra, and in "pure" ultralights, with a couple friends at Shoestring ultralight park, in PA. Work is also proceeding slowly on the "rebuild" of my Colt and the three Challengers, somewhat accelerated by the time change, mostly due to its positive effect on my motivation. I'm optimistically hoping to see Zippy and two of the C-2s flying by June or July. I'm not the only one in the club making progress on their projects. As nearly as I can tell, EAA571 will see at least 3 new aircraft completions in 2004, and several more are moving along at a respectable pace.

In spite of this, I couldn't help but feel a tinge of envy as I stumbled across the web site for EAA478 Leonardtown, MD (<http://eaa478.tripod.com/>) and learned that, as a club project, they are building a replica of an aircraft that I have recently developed a fascination for, the Curtiss AH-1 "Triad", a derivative of the venerable Curtiss Pusher. The Triad was one of the Navy's first aircraft (actually 2 out of three, the third being a Wright "B"). It is an obscure bit of local history that those three planes, a tent, and a handful of men, comprised the Navy's first Naval Air Station, located across the Severn from the Naval Academy, on Greenberry Point. At least one of the major buildings on the Academy is named after one of those intrepid aviators. The Triad was the first true amphibious aircraft (heavier than air).
