About the EOGR

History: In September 1961, the Ottawa District Council held a Woodbadge course for Cub Leaders at Camp Ave Maria, which later became known as Camp Echon.

The participants in this course had so much fun and enjoyed the fellowship of their fellow Scouters so much that they decided to get together in a year to reminisce and swap yarns from the course.

When the time came for the reunion in 1962, the organizing committee decided to extend an invitation to other Scouters entitled to wear the Gilwell Beads and Neckerchief. A great time was had by all and this started what was to become an annual event - The Eastern Ontario Gilwell Reunion (EOGR).

Format: EOGR is a day long event at Camp Opemikon near Perth and traditionally held on the 3rd weekend in September. It is a fun-filled day where

Scouters with WB II can take part in any or all events that are offered, or take the opportunity to talk with other WB II Scouters.

While the formal Reunion takes place on Saturday, Scouters can choose to stay for the full weekend from Friday evening (Camp out at the EOGR Warm-up, go for a hike) until Sunday afternoon, for Saturday and Sunday, or just for the formal event on Saturday. The fees reflect these differences.

Events: Past events have included volleyball, orienteering, knot sessions, hiking, service projects, as well as two activities that have a long and distinguished history.

"Christie Cup Challenge": a croquet game. This is not just any old civilized "British" game of Croquet. This is "EOGR RULES" croquet. You have to come to see the fun.

"Jubilee Jug Challenge": A different event each year, along with many other events round out the weekend.

However you look at it, the EOGR is a great way to charge your Scouting batteries and get ready for the events yet to come in another fun filled Scouting year.

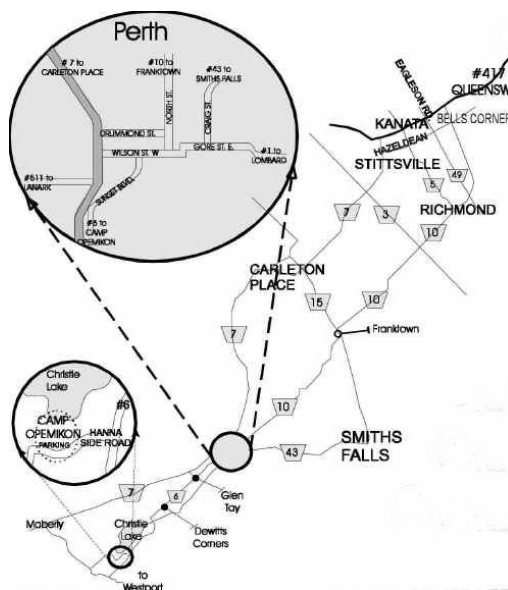
