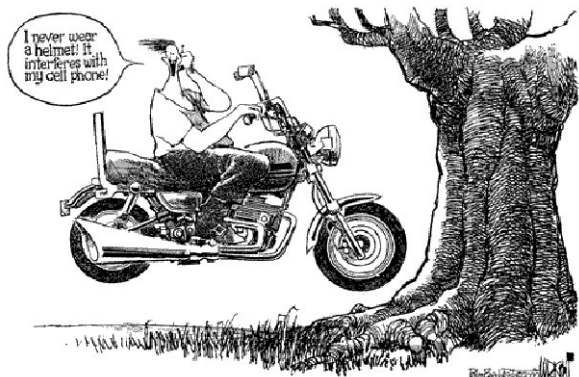


# E-Hams
