CASE 9. VALENTINE HYDE against HILL.

Issue born abroad are aliens. Cro. Car. 602. 7 Co. 18. Vaugh. 279. 1 C. Dig. 297.

Ejectione firmæ. It- was held upon evidence, that if baron and feme English- go heyond sea without licence, or tarry there after, the time limited by the licence, and have issue, that the issue is an alien, (a) and not inheritable, contrary to the opinion of Hussey, 1 Rich. 3. pl. 4.
