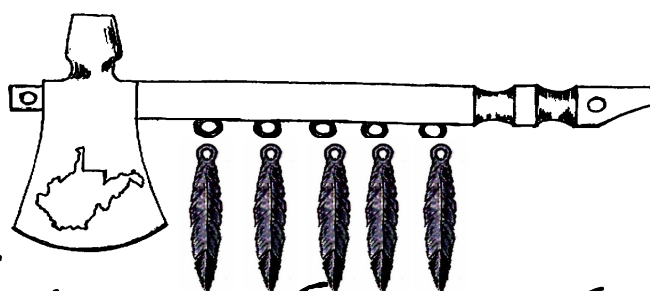

Rendezvous rules take effect Friday, Sept 22 at 7 am until September 30,
after closing ceremonies.

Camp Feast will be Wednesday, 27th of September

Attendance at a primitive event means: All clothing, lodges and accouterments must be in the period of 1640 through 1840 in **North America**. Absolutely no modern footwear and sunglasses of any kind, unless medically required. Period eyewear is encouraged for those wearing eyeglasses. Eye & hearing protection is encouraged on the firing line only! All modern items (cooler, bottles, cans, plastic, etc.) must be kept out of sight at all times. Absolutely no propane, kerosene heaters, Coleman lanterns or charcoal lighter fluid will be permitted. All cell phones must be kept out of sight at all times. Firewood, water and trash pickup, and porta john will be provided. Ice will be available for purchase. Safety and conduct of young people under the age of sixteen (16) is the responsibility of their parents. Thievery & fighting of any kind will not be tolerated. Violators will be turned over to the WV State Police. **Trade Policy:** For Trade Rules, contact the Booshway, or the NRLHF. **NOTICE TO ALL-** Including dealers and possessor of FURS, CLAWS, FEATHERS, ETC. It is your responsibility to confirm the compliance of your goods with WV State & Federal laws. Contact the WVDNR at (304) 558-2784 or write-2311 Ohio Ave., Parkersburg, WV 26101. WV Business license and collection of sales tax is Traders responsibility.

Camping: Early setups will be as follows: Tuesday, Sept. 19- Thursday, Sept. 21 pre-registered sutlers & pre-registered camper. Gate hours Sept. 19- Sept 30 will be 7 am - 5pm. **Gate hours will be strictly enforced.** As always, there will be a one-hour time limit for unloading & loading vehicles starting Friday Sept 22 through September 30. This will be enforced. Vehicles must be out of camp one hour after gate closes & you must be in period attire with in one hour of your arrival and at all times in private camps starting Friday Sept 22 at 7 am. Your medallion will be required to enter the rendezvous **AT ALL TIMES**. Entry in any matches or competitions also requires your medallion. Only pre-registered campers & pre-registered sutlers will be allowed to set up Sept. 19-21st with no time limit. There will be no camping permitted in the parking lot! There will be a modern camping area with no hookups. There will be no commercial or blanket trading in the modern camping area.

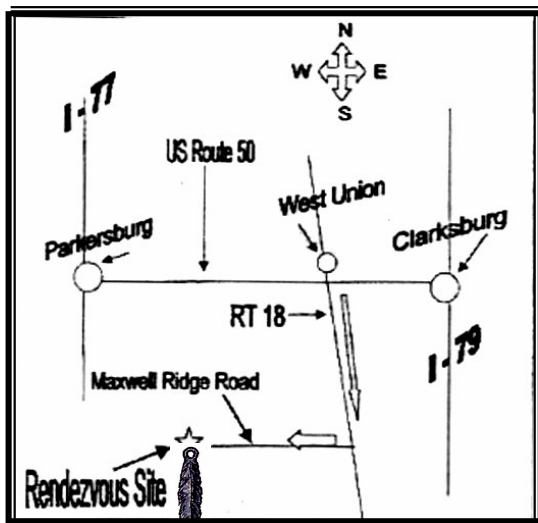
Handicapped camping area is provided and is very close to the handicapped parking area. Special considerations will be made, if necessary, to handicapped campers with regards to the possession & use of flammable liquids. **Please contact a staff member upon arrival for details.**

Primitive pack-in/trek area will be available for those who wish to use it. This area is closed to all vehicles all access is strictly carry in. **NO FACILITIES!**

Artillery will be permitted on the designated range during posted times only upon a safety inspection by the Artillery Range Officer. Range Officers have final say!!

No animals other than horses & mules are permitted. Current health & Negative Coggins Certifications will be required at the gate. No one area will be designated as horse camp! You are responsible in all ways for the health, safety & conduct of your animals. Horse Captain will have final say so over ALL camp animals. Make sure your animals are tolerant of the sights, sounds & chaos of rendezvous! **If you have any doubts, please do not bring them!** All tack, wagons, buggies & accessories must be period appropriate. All wagons & buggies must be inspected prior to use. **Dogs, cats and other pets will not be allowed in any camping or parking areas.**

VISITORS will be welcome from 9am to 4 pm on Saturday, September 23rd and Sunday, September 24th with a fee of \$5.00 for each person 18 & over. We will also have an organized school day on Tuesday, September 26th from 9am to 3pm. As always, **NO PETS WILL BE ALLOWED** in camp or in the parking lot. **Notice!!! If you plan to come visit in period dress be prepared to pay a \$35.00 (per adult) deposit at the gate. \$30.00 to be reimbursed by 5pm on the same day when you leave.**



Take US Route 50 to West Union, Doddridge County

Take ST Route 18 South (9.5 miles) to the marked Maxwell Ridge Road exit. (there are two exits, depending on which way you are coming from.)

Take Maxwell Ridge Road west (5.5 miles) until you get to the site.

NOTE!!! Attachable feathers for the medallion can be earned by volunteering. Earn your first of the five feathers at a work detail. Check the web site for complete details.
