TOEFL® — Test of English as a Foreign Language™

The purpose of the TOEFL test is to evaluate the English proficiency of people whose native language is not English. In 2001-02, more than 700,000 people registered to take the test.

TOEFL scores are required for purposes of admission by more than 4,400 two- and four-year colleges and universities worldwide. In addition, government agencies, scholarship programs, and licensing/certification agencies use TOEFL scores to evaluate English proficiency.

The test is offered in two formats: computer-based and paper-based. The computer-based test is offered in most parts of the world. In areas where access to the computer-based test is limited, the paper-based version of the test is administered. This *Bulletin* contains information about both formats of the test. **Information about the paper-based test is on pages 20-27. The registration form needed to register for the paper-based test is contained in the self-addressed envelope in the center of the *Bulletin*.**

If you do not know which version of the test is offered in your country or area, refer to the computer-based test center list on pages 18-19. If your country or area is not listed, refer to the paper-based test center list on pages 26-27.

The Computer-Based Test

The computer-based TOEFL test is offered year-round at institutional sites such as colleges and universities and at testing centers operated by Prometric, a division of Thomson Learning.

The computer-based TOEFL test has four sections, all of which are mandatory at each administration.

- **Listening** measures the ability to understand English as it is spoken in North America. This section tests comprehension of main ideas, supporting ideas, important details, and inferences. You will both see and hear the questions before the answer choices appear.
- **Structure** measures the ability to recognize language that is appropriate for standard written English. The language tested is formal, rather than conversational. When topics have a national context, they refer to United States or Canadian history, culture, art, or literature. However, knowledge of these contexts is not needed to answer the questions.

- **Reading** measures the ability to understand short passages similar in topic and style to academic texts used in North American colleges and universities. You will read a variety of short passages on academic subjects and answer several questions about each passage.
- **Writing** measures the ability to write in English on an assigned topic. **You must compose an essay in order to receive a total score.**

Payment Policies

See box at right for preferred forms of payment.

All test payments must be made in full, be dated within 90 days of the date of receipt at the Regional Registration Center (RRC), have the correct numeric and written dollar amount, and have appropriate signature(s). Post-dated checks will not be accepted.

Bank drafts, money orders, checks, and Eurochecks in U.S. dollars must be drawn on a bank in the United States and made payable to ETS-TOEFL. The bank name and its address should be preprinted on the face of the check.

Checks in Canadian dollars must be drawn on a bank in Canada at the prevailing rate of the U.S. dollar plus GST/HST/QST. See page 5 for instructions for submitting your payment.

Services may be withheld for nonpayment of fees. If you do not submit the correct fee, your registration or request for service will be returned. Scores will not be released if a payment is returned for any reason.

Do not send cash or demand drafts. Receipts for bank checks or money orders are not acceptable. The actual negotiable check or money order must be sent with your request for service.

CBT Voucher Request Form

If you do not have a credit card or you do not want to give your credit card number over the telephone, you can complete a CBT Voucher Request Form. Follow these steps:

- Fill in all the information on the form (center of this *Bulletin*).
- Include credit card information (Discover, JCB, VISA, MasterCard, or American Express) or a money order or check payable to ETS-TOEFL (see above for preferred forms of payment).
- Mail the form and payment to Educational Testing Service, PO Box 6159, Princeton, NJ 08541-6159, USA, or use the envelope and label in this *Bulletin*.
- In two to four weeks, you will receive a voucher number. You can then schedule an appointment to take the CBT by using the 16-digit voucher number. Do NOT call before you receive your voucher. Vouchers are valid for one year from date of issue. If you do not receive your CBT voucher, or if you have lost it, call 1-609-771-7100.

Refund Policy

A partial refund of US\$65 is available if you cancel your appointment within the proper time period (see page 5), have paid for a CBT voucher but have not used it, or you have an unused paper-based admission ticket for the test.

CBT Appointment Scheduling

Schedule an appointment by using one of the methods below.

Make an Appointment by Using a Credit Card and Calling...

To schedule by phone, you will need a valid credit card: VISA, MasterCard, or American Express. You will be given an appointment confirmation number. Be sure to write it down. You will also get a test date, reporting time, and test center address when you call. Look at the International Test Scheduling Form (center of *Bulletin*) for the information you will be asked for when you call.

Complete an International Test Scheduling Form

If you are testing outside the United States, Canada or a U.S. territory* and you do not want to schedule an appointment over the telephone...

- Fill in all the information on the International Test Scheduling Form (center of *Bulletin*). Be sure to indicate two test center choices.
- Include credit card information (VISA, MasterCard, American Express, or CBT voucher). (See page 4 for other preferred forms of payment and payment policies.)
- Mail or fax the completed form to the RRC for your area (see page 17). Follow the instructions given on the back of the form.

You will be assigned a test date, time, and location based on the information you provide. If no appointments are available you will be assigned to a date as close as possible to your choices. If your assigned test date does not meet your needs, contact the RRC within 24 hours of receipt of the letter notifying you of your appointment.

If you do not receive a confirmation of your appointment, you must call the RRC at least **three business days** prior to your first-choice appointment. If your choices are not in sequential order, you must call the RRC at least three business days prior to the earliest appointment choice.

Scheduling Hints

- Make your appointment early; test centers fill up quickly.
- Take the test as soon as possible so your scores will be received in time to be considered with your application.
- Appointments are not transferrable. You are not allowed to give your testing appointment to someone else.

You will not be admitted if you do not have the proper identification. See pages 6-7. The name you give when you register must match the name on the identification document you will present at the test center.

Walk-In Scheduling

If you are testing in the United States, Canada, or a U.S. territory* **ONLY**:

- Go to a test center on the day you would like to test and see whether testing appointments are available. You are **NOT** guaranteed an appointment. Unscheduled examinees are admitted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Take your CBT voucher, if you have one.

- Be sure to take your valid passport or other acceptable form of identification (see pages 6-7).

Rescheduling or Canceling

- If you are testing in the United States or a U.S. territory,* call 1-800-GO-TOEFL (1-800-468-6335) or the test center directly no later than **three business days** before your appointment.
- If you are testing outside the United States, Canada, or a U.S. territory,* call the RRC no later than three business days before your appointment for a permanent center and at least five business days before your appointment for a center with limited testing. The RRC must receive payment prior to rescheduling your appointment. Appointments cannot be rescheduled beyond one year of the original appointment date.

If you do not cancel or reschedule as indicated above, your full test fee will be forfeited. You will be charged US\$40 if you reschedule. Appointments cannot be rescheduled between sites (outside the United States and U.S. territories*) — for example, Paris, France, to Melbourne, Australia. You must provide your appointment confirmation number and the full name you used to make an appointment when you call.

* American Samoa, Guam, Puerto Rico, and U.S. Virgin Islands

Identification (ID) Requirements

How to use this information: All test takers **must read Part 1**. Depending on whether you will be testing within or outside your country of citizenship, you must also read **either Part 2 or Part 3**, as appropriate.

All test takers in Bangladesh, India, and Pakistan must use valid passports as their ID documents.

Part 1: Information for ALL Test Takers

- You must have acceptable and valid ID to be admitted to a test center. Identification requirements are strictly enforced. It is your responsibility to read and understand the instructions and requirements.
- If you arrive at the test center without the required identification, the test center administrator will not admit you, you cannot test, and you will forfeit your test fee.
- **When scheduling your appointment or completing your registration form, you must use exactly the same name that appears on the primary identification document you will present at the test center.** If the name shown on your primary identification does not match the name on your appointment record, you will not be permitted to test.
- **Only misspellings of your name can be corrected at check-in — NAME CHANGES WILL NOT BE MADE.** If your name has changed for any reason, including marriage, you still must present primary identification in the name under which you made the appointment, or you will not be permitted to test.
- If the test center administrator questions the ID you present, you will be required to present additional proof of identity. If positive confirmation cannot be made, you may be refused admission to the test center.
- Test center personnel will check your identification before assigning you a seat at the test center and you will be asked to sign the test center log. The administrator will check your signature to verify that you are the person in your photo identification. The administrator will repeat this procedure before and after all breaks.
- Admittance to the test center does not imply that your form of identification is valid or that your scores will be reported. All reported cases of questionable identification are subject to review and approval by the ETS Test Security Office.

Secondary Identification Documents

If your primary identification, specified in **Part 2** or **Part 3**, is missing either a **photo** or a **signature**, you must present one of the following *secondary IDs* in addition to your primary ID. Secondary IDs that can be used to meet the photograph and/or signature requirements are

- a government-issued identification document that has not expired (including but not limited to passport, driver's license, national identification, or military

identification). There are some exceptions: see “Unacceptable Identification Documents” below

- student ID
- confirmation of identity letter from your educational institution. The letter must contain your name, date of birth, a recent, recognizable photograph, your signature, and the date issued. It must be typed on the original letterhead of the education institution you attend(ed), and the signature of the school official and the school seal must overlap your photograph. A letter of identity is valid for only one year after the date issued.

Unacceptable Identification Documents

- any expired ID
- international driver's license
- Social Security card
- draft classification card
- credit card of any kind
- notary-prepared letter or document
- employee identification card

If You Cannot Meet the Specified ID Requirements or If You Have Questions About ID

If you do not have the required ID, or if you have questions about meeting the ID requirements, you **must** contact the ETS Test Security Office (1-609-406-5430, fax: 1-609-406-9709, or email: TSReturns@ets.org) **before you complete your registration form or schedule an appointment to test.**

Part 2: If Testing OUTSIDE Your Country of Citizenship

You MUST PRESENT YOUR PASSPORT as your *primary identification* document (citizens of European and Schengen Zone countries, see special requirements below). If you do not meet this requirement, ETS may automatically cancel your test scores.

If your passport is **not written in English language letters**, you must also present an additional ID from the list of *secondary identification documents* (see Part 1) that contains a recent, recognizable photo and is in English.

If your passport **does not contain your signature**, you must either sign your passport or present an additional ID from the list of *secondary identification documents*.

U.S. military personnel may present their U.S. military ID cards for admission to test centers.

European Union/Schengen Zone Countries

If you are taking the test within a European Union or Schengen Zone country outside your own, you may use your valid national or European identity card if you have one. The card you present must contain a recent, recognizable **photograph**, your **date of birth**, and your **signature**. If

your form of identification is **not in English language letters** and the test administrator cannot read the language in which it is written, you may not be allowed to test. If your official ID **does not contain your signature**, you must present an additional document from the list of *secondary identification documents* (see Part I) that does contain your signature.

Part 3: If Testing **WITHIN** Your Country of Citizenship

You must present **ONE** of the following *primary identification* documents:

- **passport** with photograph and signature
- **driver's license** with photograph and signature
- **national identification** with photograph and signature
- **military identification** with photograph and signature

If your primary ID does not contain your signature, you must either sign the document or present an additional ID from the list of *secondary identification documents* (see Part I). The secondary ID must contain a recent, recognizable photograph and your signature.

Sample Confirmation-of-Identity Letter

If you present a letter as an identification document, it must be an original letter, not a photocopy of a letter, and it must contain items 1-9 as listed below. (Letters are valid for one year from the date issued.)

- (1) Official letterhead of your school.
- (2) Your name. Remember, the name you use when you schedule an appointment or fill out a registration form is the name that must appear on your confirmation-of-identity letter.
- (3) Your date of birth.

- (5) Date the letter was issued. A letter of identity is valid for only one year.
- (6) Your photograph, glued to the letter.
- (7) The seal of your school, overlapping your photograph.
- (8) The signature and title of the official who issued the letter, overlapping your photograph.
- (9) Your signature.

Preparing for the CBT Test

About the Computer-Based Test

The entire test session is approximately 4 hours long: 40 minutes to complete the tutorials and about 3-1/2 hours to complete the four sections of the test. The tutorials teach computer skills needed to take the test and describe how to answer questions in each test section.

The computer-based TOEFL test has four sections: Listening, Structure, Reading, and Writing. The chart below indicates the approximate number of questions and time to complete each section.

The scores of all test takers are based on the same number of questions; however, because additional questions (used for research purposes only) are randomly distributed in tests, the number of questions in each section and the time allowed to complete each section may vary. The total amount of time allowed for a section is stated in the directions. The time allowed to respond is displayed at the beginning of each section.

You should look at this information before beginning each test section.

The current question number, the total number of questions in the section, and the time remaining in the section are displayed. The display changes as you proceed through a section. For example, you may see question 5 of 20 and 00:17 minutes remaining, or you may see question 13 of 20 and 00:08 minutes remaining. Use this information to check your progress so that you will finish all the questions before time runs out.

In the Writing section, you must compose an essay based on the one topic assigned randomly from a large pool of topics. An essay on any other topic will be scored a zero. Once you are presented with your topic, do not click on Next/Confirm Answer until you have finished typing. You will be given 30 minutes to complete your essay.

NOTE: You must answer at least one question in each section and compose an essay every time you take the test to receive an official score report.

Computer-Adaptive Testing

The Listening and Structure sections of the test are computer adaptive, meaning that questions in these sections are chosen from a large pool of questions categorized by difficulty and content. The questions are chosen by the computer, based on how you answer the previous questions. For instance, the first question you receive will be of average difficulty. The question you receive next will be one that best fits your performance (how well you did on the previous question) and the design of the test. The Reading and Writing sections are not computer adaptive.

The test design for both paper and computer assures that all test takers will be tested on similar skills (e.g., comprehension of main idea, understanding of inferences) and subject matter (a variety of topics for lectures and passages).

Test Section	Number of Questions	Time to Complete
Listening	30-49 questions	15-25 minutes to answer questions. 40-60 minutes to complete entire section. Clock runs while you are answering questions, but not while you are listening to conversations and talks.
Structure	20-25 questions	15-20 minutes to complete questions.
Reading	44-55 questions	70-90 minutes to complete section (includes time spent reading passages and answering questions).
Writing	one assigned topic	30 minutes to write an essay.

How often can I take the computer-based TOEFL test? If I cancel my scores, can I take the test again?

You may take the computer-based TOEFL test only once in any calendar month, even if you took the test and canceled your scores. For example, if you test in July, you must wait until August to take it again. If you test more than once in a calendar month, your new scores will not be reported and your test fee will not be refunded. Violation of this policy may also result in additional action being taken.

NOTE: Only ETS can answer questions about score comparability or other score-related questions.

Essential Guidelines for All CBT Test Takers

We strongly urge you to carefully review the following information as you prepare for your test and *before* you arrive at the test center. It could help improve your chances for success.

- **Learn about the test.** It's always best to know as much as possible about what to expect before you arrive at the test center.
- **Once you know what to expect on your test, it's time to practice.** At a minimum you should answer some **sample questions** from each section of the test (available on the TOEFL Web site, www.toefl.org) to get familiar with them. You can also purchase test preparation materials through the Web site.
- **Try practice test questions under timed conditions to get used to the pace of the test.** In other words, if there are 20 questions in a section and you have a total of 40 minutes to complete the section, give yourself an **average** of two minutes to complete each sample question. When you are practicing, keep your time in mind and remember that **if you spend too much time on one question, you will have less time to spend on others.**
- **Use the computer tutorial to your advantage.** When you arrive at the test center on test day you must complete a computer tutorial before the actual test begins. You can spend **as much time as you need** to make yourself familiar and comfortable with the computer **before** you start the timed sections of the test. Don't start until you are ready. Once the test is under way, you can always click on "Help" to review the directions or a summary of the tutorial again, but be aware that **this will count against your allotted time** for that section of the test.

You can also download the tutorial for free from the TOEFL Web site.

- **Pace yourself.** Use the *Bulletin*, Web site, test preparation material, software, or CDs to become familiar with the test and test instructions **before** you get to the test center. Read the directions carefully before you begin. The directions at the beginning of each test section tell you the total number of questions in that section as well as total time allotted for that section. Try to budget enough time for each question so you will be able to complete the test without having to rush at the end of each section. Keep in mind the average amount of time you may want to spend per question. Once you start

the test, an onscreen clock display will continuously count down the remaining time. You can hide this display if you want, but it is a good idea to check the clock periodically to monitor your progress. The clock will alert you when five minutes remain in the allotted time for that section.

- **Use your time wisely.** Read each question carefully. Eliminate the wrong answers and select the best choice. Don't let yourself get stuck on a tough question and lose time. Keep moving through the test and try to finish each section.
- **Computer-adaptive tests require that you answer every question in the order it is presented.** You cannot skip a question and go back. The computer selects the next question you see from a large pool of available questions based upon your previous responses.
- **Computer-adaptive tests are scored differently than most paper-and-pencil tests.** Your score depends on such factors as
 - the number of questions you answered within the allotted time
 - your performance on questions answered throughout the test
 - the level of difficulty of those questions in relation to your overall performance at that point in the test
- **Do not spend too much time on any one question.** If, after you've given a question a reasonable amount of thought, you still don't know the answer, eliminate as many answer choices as possible and then select and confirm the answer you think is best.
- **If you are running out of time at the end of a section, make every effort to complete the test.** Data indicate that on average most candidates get higher scores if they **finish** the test. In fact, based on analyses of test takers, a majority of test takers will score higher if they finish the test than if they do not attempt to answer all the questions. However, there is a chance that guessing at the end of the test can seriously lower your score. The best strategy is to pace yourself so that you have time to consider each test question, so you don't have to guess.
- Read each question carefully and thoroughly. Before answering a question, determine exactly what is being asked. Always read and understand all possible answers. If you do not, you may miss important information.
- Remember that if you exit the test, you will **NOT** be able to return to it.

Listening Section

- Try to answer as quickly as you can so what you listened to remains fresh in your mind.
- Read the questions as well as listen to them.
- After listening to and reading the questions, try to think of the answers before looking at the options. Then quickly scan the options and find the one that matches your prediction.
- Use the visuals that accompany the conversations and talks. They contain important information.

Listening and Structure Sections

- You must answer each question in the Listening and Structure sections (the computer-adaptive sections). You cannot skip questions or go back and change answers. If you do not know the answer to a question, first eliminate any answer choices that are obviously incorrect before making a guess. Confirm your answer only when you are certain you are ready to move to the next question. Random guessing could lower your score.

Reading Section

- Read each passage carefully before answering the questions.
- In the Reading section, you can return to questions and change your answers. You can also skip a question and return to it later.
- To use your time well, it is best to answer all the questions about one reading passage before going on to the next one.

Writing Section

- Before taking the test, practice writing several 30-minute essays.
- Decide before you take the test whether to handwrite or type your essay. If you decide to type it, use the TOEFL *Sampler* or PowerPrep® software (visit the TOEFL Web site) to become familiar with the word processing program. Remember that if you decide to handwrite your essay, you must write it on the single page, two-sided essay form you will be given at the test center.
- Essay readers judge how well details, examples, and reasons support or illustrate the points being made.

NOTE: If you handwrite your essay, your scores will be mailed from ETS approximately five weeks after the test date. If you compose the essay on the computer, your scores will be mailed from ETS approximately two weeks after the test date.

CBT Test Day

Admission to the CBT Test Center

When you go to the test center you must have:

- **official photobearing identification** (see pages 6-7). Your identification will be checked before you are admitted. The name given when making your appointment must match the name on the identification document you will present at the test center.
- **appointment confirmation number.** This will be given to you when you schedule your appointment.
- **CBT voucher**, if you have one.

Be prepared to select the institutions to which you would like your scores sent. (See page 13 for more information.)

CBT Test Center Procedures and Regulations

The following procedures and regulations apply during the entire test session, which begins at sign-in and ends at sign-out and includes breaks.

- Report to the test center at least 30 minutes before your scheduled appointment for check-in procedures. If you arrive late, you may not be admitted and your fee will not be refunded.
- If you have a CBT voucher, take it to the test center.
- The test will be given on the day and at the time assigned to you by the Prometric Candidate Services Call Center, the test center, or the RRC.
- You will be required to write and sign a confidentiality statement at the test center. If you do not complete and sign the statement, you will not be permitted to test and you will forfeit your test fee.
- Friends or relatives who accompany you to the test center will not be permitted to wait in the test center or contact you while you are taking the examination.
- You will be required to write your signature before and after the test session and at any time you leave or enter the testing room.
- You will be assigned a seat.
- Your picture will be taken and will be reproduced on your score report and at your testing station. Be sure the correct photograph is displayed on your assigned testing station.

This photograph will be printed on your examinee's score record and, in most instances, will be printed on the official score reports sent to institutions. It may also be supplied to United States and Canadian law enforcement agencies.

- ID verification may include thumb-printing, photographing, videotaping, or other form of electronic ID confirmation. If you refuse to participate you will not be permitted to test and will forfeit your test fee. This is in addition to the requirements that you must present acceptable and valid identification.
- Dress so that you can adapt to any room temperature.
- You may not eat, drink, or use tobacco during the administration.
- There will be a mandatory five-minute break midway through the testing session. If you exceed the time allotted, you may be dismissed or your scores may be canceled. If for some reason you must leave your seat at any other time, raise your hand. Timing of the section will not stop during an unscheduled break.
- Excessive or lengthy departures from your workstation will be documented by the test administrator and will be reported to ETS.
- You may not leave the test center during the test session and breaks.
- You may not refer to or use any testing materials or aids at any time during the testing session or breaks. These include paper, pencils, beepers, pagers, pens, calculators, watch calculators, books, pamphlets, rulers, highlighter pens, stereos or radios with headphones, telephones/cell phones, electronic dictionaries, watch alarms, dictionaries, translators, and any electronic or photographic devices. After you check in and before you enter the testing room, you will be asked to deposit such items in a locker. Storage space is limited so please plan accordingly. Test centers assume no responsibility for candidates' personal belongings. You may not have access to your locker during the test administration.
- Scratch paper is provided following the break to aid you in organizing your essay. Scratch paper and note taking are not permitted during the Listening and Structure sections. If you decide to handwrite your essay, writing material will be provided. Once the time has ended for the essay section, you must stop writing and hand in your essay. All scratch paper must be returned to the test center administrator.
- **You must compose an essay, and if you choose to handwrite it, you must write it on the TOEFL CBT Hand-written Essay Form.**
- **DO NOT click on Next and Confirm Answer** until you have finished typing or writing your essay.

- If you write on anything but this form, your essay will not be scored. **Time will not start until you have received your essay form.**
- **You must answer at least one question in each section and write an essay every time you take the test to receive an official score report.**
- If at any time during the test you believe you have a problem with your computer or need the administrator for any reason, raise your hand.
- All testing sessions will be videotaped.

The center administrator is authorized to dismiss you from a test session, or ETS may cancel your scores for

- attempting to take the test for someone else
- failing to provide acceptable identification
- obtaining improper access to the test, a part of the test, or information about the test
- using any prohibited aid in connection with the test
- creating a disturbance
- bringing a weapon or firearm into the test center
- attempting to give or receive assistance, or otherwise communicate, in any form, with another person about the test during the test administration
- copying or paraphrasing someone else's work
- taking food or drink into the testing room
- attempting to remove test content from the testing room is prohibited. Under no circumstances may test content or any part of the test content be removed, reproduced, and/or disclosed by any means (e.g., hard copy, verbally, electronically) to any person or entity.
- exceeding time permitted for the scheduled break
- attempting to remove scratch paper from the testing room (CBT)
- leaving the testing room without permission
- attempting to tamper with a computer
- failing to follow any of the test administration regulations contained in this *Bulletin*, given by the test administrator, or specified in any test materials

NOTE: ETS reserves the right to take all action, including, but not limited to, barring you from future testing and/or canceling your scores for failure to comply with the test administrator's directions. If your scores are canceled, they will not be reported, and your test fee will not be refunded. You will not be eligible to register for another test until the next calendar month.

CBT Scoring and Score Reporting

How Your CBT Test Is Scored

Your scores are based on your performance on the questions presented, the difficulty of the questions presented, and the number of questions you answered. More credit is given for correctly answering a hard question than for correctly answering an easy question.

NOTE: You must answer at least one question in each section and write an essay every time you take the test to receive an official score report.

Your score from the Structure section will be combined with your essay rating from the Writing section to form a Structure/Writing scale score. When viewed at the test center, the Structure/Writing score will be shown in a range because your essay will not yet have been read and rated.

For the computer-based test, you will receive four scale scores: Listening (0 to 30), Structure/Writing (0 to 30), Reading (0 to 30), and a total score (0 to 300).

The essay you compose in the Writing section will be independently rated by two qualified readers using the Writing Scoring Guide on this page. Neither reader will know the rating assigned by the other. Your essay will receive the average of the two ratings unless there is a discrepancy of more than one point; in that case, a third reader will independently rate your essay. Your essay will thus receive a final rating of 6.0, 5.5, 5.0, 4.5, 4.0, 3.5, 3.0, 2.5, 2.0, 1.5, or 1. A score of "0" will be given to papers that are blank, written on scratch paper, simply copy the topic, are written in a language other than English, consist only of random keystroke characters, or are written on a topic different from the one assigned. **You are required to compose an essay every time you take the test.**

Your essay rating will be incorporated into the Structure/Writing scale score, with the rating of the essay constituting approximately one half of the Structure/Writing scale score. The rating will appear on your score report under the heading "essay rating." It is provided as a service to help you and your institution better understand your Structure/Writing score.

Writing Scoring Guide

- 6 An essay at this level**
 - effectively addresses the writing task
 - is well organized and well developed
 - uses clearly appropriate details to support a thesis or illustrate ideas
 - displays consistent facility in the use of language
 - demonstrates syntactic variety and appropriate word choice

Viewing Scores at the CBT Center

You will be able to view your scores on the computer screen immediately following the test. You will see your complete scores for Listening and Reading; however, your Structure/Writing and total scores will be shown to you as score ranges because your essay will not yet have been read and rated. Your final score will be within the range shown on the screen. For example, you might see the following:

In this example, your final total score would be somewhere between 157 and 223.

To obtain the total TOEFL score, add the scale scores for the three sections and multiply by ten thirds. The example shows how the three scale section scores are used to obtain the total score.

After viewing your scores on screen, you can choose to report them or cancel them. At the end of your test, you will see on the computer screen a list of institutions and instructions about how to select them (the list is also on pages 28-33). For institutions in the United States, you will need to know the name of the state in which the institution is located. If you do not see the institution you would like to designate, ask the test center administrator for a Score Report Request Form. Fill out the form completely and return it to the test administrator before you leave the test center. If you do not select institutions on the test day, you must pay US\$15 per institution to have scores sent at a later date.

NOTE: Test centers do not provide receipts or printed scores for the test.

Interpreting Your Scores

Test scores cannot be perfectly precise. A person's score can increase or decrease just by chance from one test administration to another, even when there is no change in the person's true proficiency. The standard error of measurement is the index that describes the degree of precision in a measurement. In the case

of the computer-based TOEFL test, the standard error of measurement of the total score is approximately 11 scale score points. This means that if an examinee's "true" proficiency score — the score the person would earn if the test could measure his or her ability with perfect precision — is, for example, 220, the chances are about two out of three that the person's observed score will be somewhere between 209 and 231 (220 plus or minus 11).

The TOEFL CBT Percentile Rank Table will help you interpret the scores on your score record.

To illustrate the use of the table, let us assume that your total score is 200. Your section scores are 18 on Listening, 20 on Structure/Writing, and 22 on Reading.

First, look at the area in the table labeled "Total Score." Then, in the column under "Your Score," find the score 200. In the "Percentile Rank"* column, opposite the 200, you will see the number 34. This number means that you achieved a higher score than approximately 34 percent of all people who took the test from July 2001 through June 2002.

Now, look at the area in the table labeled "Section Scores." For Listening, under "Your Score," look for 18. The next column, "Percentile Rank," opposite the 18, indicates that you achieved a higher score on Listening than approximately 28 percent of all who took the test. For Structure/Writing, find the score of 20 under "Your Score." By reading across, you can see that you achieved a higher score than approximately 33 percent of

the examinees on Structure/Writing. For Reading, the table shows you that, with a score of 22, you achieved a higher score on Reading than approximately 46 percent of all those who took the test. If you took the paper-based test in the past and would like to compare the scores you receive on the computer-based test, see "Comparing Test Scores" on page 13.

Interpreting your Essay Rating

Use the CBT Essay Percentile Rank Table to help you interpret your score. Assume that your essay score is 4.0. Under "Your Score" in the table, find the score 4.0. In the "Percentile Rank"* column, opposite 4.0, is the number 49. This number means that you achieved a higher score on the essay test than approximately 49 percent of all people who took the test from (July 2001 through June 2002).

Canceling Your Scores

Although you will have the option of canceling your scores after the test, you should consider very carefully before doing so. Your scores will be reported to institutions only if you request that they be. If you do cancel your scores, they will not be reported to you or to any institutions, and no refund will be made.

If you cancel your scores and you decide within 60 days that you would like to have them reinstated, you may call, fax, or mail a written request to TOEFL Services (See page 39 for contact information). The fee for reinstatement is US\$10. Your request should include your name, date of birth, daytime phone number, appointment number, and payment (see "Preferred Forms of Payment" and "Payment Policies," page 4). Scores will be reinstated and reported to you in approximately two weeks.

NOTE: You are allowed to take the test only once in a calendar month. This includes test administrations at which you decide to cancel your scores. If you test more than once in a calendar month, your new scores will not be reported and your test fee will not be refunded.

Examinee's Score Record, Official Score Reports

Your test fee entitles you to

- one printed examinee's score record
- up to four official score reports sent free of charge from ETS to institutions you designate on the day of the test. **If you do not select institutions on the test day, you must pay US\$15 per institution to have scores sent later.**

The printed score report will contain the Listening and Reading section scores that you saw at the test center, your final Structure/Writing section score, and your total score, as well as your essay rating.

PLEASE NOTE: If you handwrite your essay, your scores will be mailed approximately five weeks after the test date. If you compose it on the computer, your scores will be mailed approximately two weeks after the test date. Under no circumstances can test results be given any earlier.

If you have not received your score record four weeks after the test (typed essay) or seven weeks after the test (handwritten essay), write to TOEFL Services, Educational Testing Service, PO Box 6151, Princeton, NJ 08541-6151,

USA, or send an email to toefl@ets.org.

If your address changes after you take the test, be sure to contact TOEFL Services in Princeton, NJ at the above address.

Ordering Additional Score Reports

You can use the TOEFL Score Report Request Form on page 37 if you want TOEFL Services-Princeton to send official score reports to institutions other than those you indicate on the day of the test. Be sure to include your 16-digit appointment confirmation number. You cannot delete or change a designated institution after you have made a request. Scores more than two years old cannot be reported or verified.

NOTE: TOEFL scores are measurement information and are subject to all restrictions on release of information indicated in this *Bulletin*. They are not the property of the examinee.

Comparing Test Scores

Paper-based and computer-based TOEFL tests are similar in many ways. For example, both tests consist of multiple-choice questions that measure an examinee's ability to understand spoken English, understand English reading passages, and recognize correct English grammar. Both tests also require the examinee to write an essay. However, there are some important score-related differences between the paper-based and computer-based TOEFL tests.

One important difference is that the total score of the computer-based test includes information about the examinee's ability to write an essay, but the total score for the paper-based test does not. Although all paper-based TOEFL tests include the Test of Written English (TWE), the TWE score is reported separately and not included in the examinee's total score. Also, the computer-based test contains types of Listening and Reading questions that are not in the paper-based test. Because the computer-based TOEFL test has some types of questions that are not used in the paper-based TOEFL test, scores from the computer-based and the paper-based tests do not represent exactly the same information and are thus not directly comparable.

Despite the lack of direct comparability, score users sometimes need to make informed decisions about examinees who have taken the TOEFL test in different

formats. To aid these score users, the TOEFL program developed concordance tables based on data collected from more than 9,000 examinees who took both the paper-based and computer-based versions of the test. You can use the table below to see how someone who has received a total score from a paper-based TOEFL test might have scored on a computer-based TOEFL test.

It is important to keep in mind that a concordance relationship implies a rough prediction about examinee performance, rather than equivalency of scores.

To show the use of the table, let us assume that the total score for the paper-based test is 500:

- In the table below, look in the left column at the paper-based total. The score of 500 falls in the 500-517 range.
- Look in the right column at the computer-based total. The 500-517 range for the paper-based total corresponds to a range of 173 to 187 for the computer-based total.

Because this paper-based test score of 500 is at the lowest end of the range, this score corresponds approximately to the lowest computer-based score in the corresponding range, which is 173. This means that if the examinee had taken a computer-based test instead of a paper-based test, the score might have been around 173. This number is merely an estimate because the actual computer-based score would depend on the examinee's ability to write an essay and answer types of questions that are not included in the paper-based TOEFL test.

About the Paper-Based Test

The paper-based TOEFL test is offered six times a year in specific locations throughout the world (see test center list, pages 26-27). The test takes about 3 and 1/2 hours to complete. You will be given a test book and a paper answer sheet on which to record your responses.

The test has three sections:

- **Listening Comprehension** — measures ability to understand English as it is spoken in North America.
- **Structure and Written Expression** — measures ability to recognize language that is appropriate for standard written English.
- **Reading Comprehension** — measures ability to understand nontechnical reading matter.

The Test of Written English (TWE) is a 30-minute writing test that is required of everyone taking the paper-based test. You will write a short essay on the one topic printed in your TWE test book to demonstrate your ability to write in English. This includes the ability to generate and organize ideas, to support those ideas with examples or evidence, and to compose in standard written English in response to an assigned topic. You will not need special

knowledge of the topic. There is no separate fee for the TWE.

You will write your essay on a two-sided answer sheet attached to your TOEFL answer sheet. When you are told to begin work, read the instructions and the essay question carefully. You must write only on the assigned topic. If you write an essay on a different topic, it will not be scored. You will probably want to spend a few minutes thinking about the kind of essay you will write, and you may wish to make a few brief notes. The test supervisor will tell you where to make your notes for the writing test. Plan to take at least 20 minutes to write your essay after you have read the instructions and made notes.

When you register for the TOEFL test, you will be sent free test preparation material. This material, along with additional sample questions, is also available at the TOEFL Web site, www.toefl.org.

Registration

There are two ways to register for the test.

* The TOEFL test fee may differ in certain countries. Check the TOEFL Web site for testing fees in your country.

Mail-in Registration

Complete the registration form contained in the appropriate envelope in the center of this *Bulletin*.

- Use a black lead pencil. Do not use a pen or marker.
- Print the information in the boxes.
- If you make changes, be certain to erase completely.
- Spell your name exactly as it is spelled on your identification document. **Use English letters.**
- When you fill in your date of birth, write it in this order: month, day, and year.
- Use code list C on page 34 to complete item 3 and the Native Language Codes on page 21 to complete item 4.
- Choose a test date. Be sure there is enough time for ETS to process your registration form before the registration deadline listed.
- Use the test center list on pages 26-27 to select the center where you would like to test.

NOTE: Not all centers are open on all dates. From the test center list, you must select a center scheduled to be open on the date you plan to test.

- Fill in the center's four-digit code number.
 - Sometimes all the centers in a geographic area are filled before the registration deadline date.
- Write in a second choice **ONLY** if you are willing and able to test in another city, town, or area. Test date assignment depends upon availability.
- If you live more than 200 kilometers (125 miles) from a listed paper-based or CBT test center, ETS Test Administration Services may consider opening another center for the May test date only.

- If the center you selected is filled and there is no other center nearby, you have one of two choices:

Online Registration

Identification

See pages 6-7 for identification requirements. You **MUST** have acceptable and valid identification to be admitted to the test center. The name on your registration form must match the name on your identification. It must be current and contain a recent, recognizable photo and signature.

TOEFL Admission Ticket

ETS will mail you an admission ticket. **If you have not received your ticket two weeks before the test date, call TOEFL Services at 1-609-771-7100.**

Front of the TOEFL Ticket

1. **Name.** When you receive your ticket, check to be sure your name is spelled exactly as you printed it on your registration form. If your name is printed in English letters on the required identification document that you will present at the test center (see pages 6-7), your name must be spelled the same way on your admission ticket. Also check the printing of your birth date, sex, and address.

If changes are necessary, follow the directions on the ticket. You must give the corrections to the supervisor on the day of the test.

Name **changes** cannot be made. Only misspellings of your name can be corrected.

If you correct an error in the printing of your name, **birth date, or sex**, the test center supervisor must verify the change with the information on your identification document. If the corrected information is the same, the supervisor will sign the ticket. **If the supervisor does not sign your ticket, the change will not be made.** All corrections are subject to approval by TOEFL Services. Only address changes will be accepted after the test date.

NOTE: Do NOT return the ticket; you will need it at the test center. After the test, the supervisor will collect tickets with corrections.

3. **Institution and Department Codes.** You may have official score reports sent directly to four institutions if you mark and correctly grid their code numbers and department numbers on your answer sheet.* Therefore, it is very important that you accurately complete area 3 on your admission ticket using Lists A and B on pages 28-34.

If you are applying to an institution that is not listed, contact the institution and ask for its ETS/TOEFL code number, or you can ask TOEFL Services for the code number. You must have this information before the test date so you can enter the code number on your answer sheet.

If you do not have code numbers, you will have to complete a TOEFL Score Report Request Form and pay the required fee (see pages 36-37).

If you are applying as an **undergraduate student** (that is, you have finished secondary school but have not completed your studies for a bachelor's degree), print 00 in the boxes for department code on the back of your admission ticket. Your score report will be sent to the undergraduate admissions office.

If you are applying for **graduate study** (that is, you have already earned a bachelor's degree at a college or university), look at List B: Department Codes (page 34). Find the name of the department in which you plan to study and then write the code number. If your department is not listed, write 99 in the boxes for department code on the back of your admission ticket. **You must write a department code number** so TOEFL Services can send your score report to the correct office. **If you do not write a department code, your official score report**

may be sent to the institution's undergraduate school.

For an **agency or an institution** that is not a college or university, print 00 in the boxes for department code.

Photo File Record

Before you report to the test center, you **must** do the following:

- **Sign** the photo file record.
- **Attach a recent** photograph of yourself (**taken within the last six months**) showing only your face and shoulders.
- **Write** your name, test date, registration number, and center number on the back of your photograph **before** you glue it to the photo file record in case it becomes detached.
- **Trim** your photograph so that it is **no larger** than 5×5 cm or **no smaller** than 3×3 cm. It **cannot** be larger than the designated space.
- **Glue or tape** your photo to the form. **Do NOT use staples.** Laminated copies and photocopies are **not** acceptable.

IMPORTANT: If you do **not** receive an admission ticket, but have official authorization from TOEFL Services to take the test, you **must** still take a recent photograph and the required identification to the test center. The supervisor will give you a photo file record form to complete at the center.

You must give the supervisor a recent photograph or your answer sheet will not be scored. Your photograph may be supplied to United States and Canadian law enforcement agencies.

The photograph you attach to your photo file record must be clear enough so there is no doubt about your identity. Your face in the photo must show you as you will look on the day of the test, for example, with the same hairstyle, with or without a beard.

Test Center Changes

If you are unable to go to the assigned center, you may go to another test center on the **date printed** on your admission ticket, but there is no guarantee that space or test materials

will be available for you to take the test. Do **not** telephone or go to the test center **before** the day of the test.

If you are admitted to the new test center, you must change the test center number that is printed on your admission ticket and your photo file record. The admission ticket must be given to the test center supervisor at the end of the test.

Test Center Procedures and Regulations

The same procedures are followed at all test centers to make sure that everyone has equal testing time and that the operation of each center meets criteria for standardized testing. The success of the test administration depends on your cooperation.

- You will be assigned a seat by the test center staff. You may not select your own seat.
- **TOEFL/TWE** — There is no scheduled rest break during the TOEFL/TWE test. If you become ill or need to use the toilet, you must give the supervisor your identification document(s) before you leave the room. You will not be permitted to make up the time you lose.
- You may be dismissed from the testing room or have your scores canceled if you fail to follow any of the testing regulations and instructions given by the test supervisor.
- If your scores are canceled your test fee will not be refunded.

TOEFL Services will not score the TOEFL/TWE answer sheet and will not refund the test payment of anyone who

- obtains improper access to the test, a part of the test, or information about the test
- attempts to take the test for someone else (your signature and photograph will appear on your TOEFL score reports)
- attempts to give or receive assistance, or otherwise communicate, in any form, with another person about the test content during the test administration
- copying or paraphrasing someone else's work

* If you are sponsored by an institution or agency and have given your permission to TOEFL Services, the institution or agency will also receive a copy of your official score report.

- fails to follow any of the test administration regulations contained in this *Bulletin*, given by the test supervisor, or specified in any test materials
- refers to, looks through, or works on any test, or test section, other than during the testing period for that test or test section
- marks or underlines words in the test book or makes notes in the test book or on the answer sheet
- takes dictionaries, other books, notes, scratch paper, electronic dictionaries, watch alarms, cellular phones, pagers, listening devices, recording or photographic devices, highlighters, or colored pencils or pens of any kind into the testing room
- takes tobacco, chewing gum, candy, food, or beverages into the testing room
- creates a disturbance
- attempts in any manner to remove from the test room any test content or any notes relating to the test
- leaves the testing room without permission

The supervisor must report any suspected misconduct to TOEFL Services.

NOTE: ETS reserves the right to take all action, including, but not limited to, barring you from future testing and/or canceling your scores for failure to comply with the test administrator's directions. If your scores are canceled, they will not be reported, and your test fee will not be refunded. You will not be eligible to register for another test until the next calendar month.

- During the time allowed for each section of the test, you may work only on that section. You may NOT go back to an earlier section after the supervisor announces, "Please stop work, and put your pencil down." You may be dismissed if you do so. Failure to comply with a supervisor's directions will result in the cancellation of your scores.

Admission to the Center

You must be properly registered to be admitted to the test center. You **cannot** use a canceled check as proof of registration.

- You must take your admission ticket, your signed photo file record with a recent photo, and acceptable photo identification (see page 22) with you on the testing day. **If you have not received your ticket two weeks before the test date, call TOEFL Services at 1-609-771-7100.** Your admission ticket will have a registration number printed on it. When writing to TOEFL Services, be sure to include this number.
- To guarantee space you should take the test at the center printed on your admission ticket.
- Report to the test center no later than the time printed on your admission ticket. No one will be admitted after test materials have been distributed.

Canceling Scores

You must either

- complete the score cancellation section of your answer sheet, or
- after the test, contact TOEFL Services. See page 39 of this *Bulletin* to contact TOEFL Services. TOEFL Services must receive your request to cancel your scores no later than seven days after the test date printed on your admission ticket. You may **not** cancel your scores after receiving your score report.

NOTE: You cannot cancel your score for one section of a test and have the scores for the remaining sections reported. Once canceled, your scores will not be reported to you or to any institution and you will not receive a refund of your test payment. The TOEFL program deletes canceled scores from your permanent record. Canceled scores cannot be reinstated and reported at a later date. If you wish to take the test again, you must complete a new registration form and submit it with another test payment.

Refund Policy

You may not change your test date or cancel your registration. If you do not take the test and you do not wish to register for another test date, see page 36 for a partial refund.

Paper score reports will be mailed to test takers and up to four institutions listed on your answer sheet approximately five weeks after the test date. See page 20 of the *Bulletin* for score report mailing dates. See pages 36-37 to order additional score reports.

Preparing for the TOEFL Paper-Based Test

On the day of the test, you will read a set of general test instructions. In addition, each section of the test has special directions, including sample questions.

When you take the test, work rapidly but carefully. Do not spend too much time on any one question. You may NOT use note paper, and **you may NOT write or make any marks in your test book.** You may NOT make notes on your answer sheet. You will receive credit only for answers marked in the proper places on the answer sheet.

Some questions are harder than others, but try to answer every one. Your score will be based on the number of questions you answer correctly. It is to your advantage to answer every question, even if you have to guess.

The test that you take may include one or more questions that do not count toward your score. These are new questions that help ETS determine how such questions function under actual testing conditions.

Each section of the test has a time limit. The supervisor will tell you when to start and stop each section. **You may read or work only on the section of the test you are told to work on.** If you finish one section early, you may NOT go on to the next section, and you may NOT go back to a section you have already worked on. Failure to follow this rule will be considered cheating, and your scores will be canceled.

Paper-Based TOEFL and TWE Test Results and Score Records

The TOEFL test payment entitles you to one printed examinee's score record and up to four official score reports that ETS will send directly to the institutions or agencies for which you mark the correct code numbers on your TOEFL answer sheet.* (See "TOEFL/TWE Score Reporting Services" on page 25.)

ETS will send an examinee score record to you at the most recent address you provided, and official score reports to institutions approximately five weeks after you take the test. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES CAN TEST RESULTS BE GIVEN ANY EARLIER.** If the postal service returns your score record as being undeliverable, TOEFL Services will remail it only if there is a new address on file. Therefore, if your address changes after you take the test, please contact TOEFL Services. Test results will be sent two or three weeks later to examinees whose answer sheets are not completed properly or whose answer sheets arrive late at TOEFL Services. All test results will be mailed by the final deadline — 12 weeks after the test. If you have not received your score report 12 weeks after the test, contact TOEFL Services.

NOTE: The photograph you attach to your photo file record will be printed on your examinee's score record and, in most instances, on the official score reports sent to institutions.

Your TOEFL Score Record

TOEFL test scores include three section scores and a total score. Each correct answer counts equally toward the score for that section. There is no penalty for wrong answers. The total number of correct answers is called the "raw score." (**NOTE:** Some of the questions in the test may not count toward the section or total scores.)

The raw score for each section is converted by statistical means to a number on a scale called the TOEFL test scale. The scale scores are given on score reports. The TOTAL paper-based test score is now reported on a scale that ranges from 310 to 677.

The process that is used to convert your raw scores to scale scores is called score equating. Score equating ensures that test scores are equal for persons of equal proficiency regardless of the difficulty level of the particular test taken. TOEFL scale scores are equated by methods based on item response theory.

To obtain the total TOEFL score, add the scale scores for the three sections and multiply by ten thirds. The example shows how the three scaled section scores are used to obtain the total score.

$$\begin{array}{rccccccc} & \text{Section 1} & & \text{Section 2} & & \text{Section 3} & \\ \text{Example:} & 46 & + & 54 & + & 50 & = & 150 \\ & & & & & & & (150 \times 10) \div 3 = 500 \end{array}$$

NOTE: An examinee must answer a minimum of 25 percent of the total scored questions in each section of the test at every administration to obtain a total score.

Test scores cannot be perfectly precise. A person's score can increase or decrease just by chance from one test administration to another, even when there is no change in the person's true proficiency. The standard error of measurement is the index that describes the degree of precision in a measurement. In the case of the TOEFL paper-based test, the standard error of measurement of the total score is approximately 14 scale score points. This means that if an examinee's "true" proficiency score — the score the person would earn if the test could measure his or her ability with

perfect precision — is, for example, 560, the chances are about two out of three that the person's observed score will be somewhere between 546 and 574 (560 plus or minus 14).

Interpreting Your TOEFL Paper-Based Scores

The TOEFL Percentile Rank Table will help you interpret the scores on your score record.

To illustrate the use of the table below, let us assume that your total score is 560. Your section scores are 54 on Section 1 (Listening Comprehension), 60 on Section 2 (Structure and Written Expression), and 58 on Section 3 (Reading Comprehension).

First, look at the area in the table labeled "Total Score." Then, in the column under "Your Score," find the score 560. In the "Percentile Rank" column, opposite the 560, you will see the number 44. This number means that you achieved a higher score than approximately 44 percent of all people who took the test from July 2001 through June 2002.†

Now, look at the area in the table labeled "Section Scores." For Section 1, under "Your Score," look for 54. The next column, "Percentile Rank," opposite the 54, indicates that you achieved a higher score on Section 1 than approximately 56 percent of all who took the test. For Section 2, find the score of 60 under "Your Score." By reading across, you can see that you achieved a higher score than approximately 52 percent of the examinees on Section 2. For Section 3, the table shows you that, with a score of 58, you achieved a higher score on Reading Comprehension than approximately 53 percent of all those who took the test.

* If an institution or agency makes your payment and if you have given your permission to TOEFL Services, that institution or agency will also receive a copy of your official score report.

† The percentile rank for each score point is the percentage of examinees scoring below that score plus one-half of the percentage of examinees who achieved that score.

How to Order Official Score Reports

If you need additional official score reports, you may use the TOEFL Score Report Request Form on page 37 or the Scores-by-Phone service on page 14. Call or use the form if you want TOEFL Services to send official score reports to institutions other than those whose codes you marked on your answer sheet. You cannot delete or change a designated institution after you have mailed a request.

Scores more than two years old cannot be reported or verified.

ETS advises institutions to request official verification of any test scores sent to them directly by examinees. If you do send your examinee's score record and there is a difference between the official scores and those on your score record, ETS requests that the institution send ETS a copy of the score record. At the written request of an official of the institution, ETS will report to the institution the official scores, as well as any previous scores recorded for you within the last two years. ETS will also provide information about your scores at the request of an institution that has a copy of your examinee's score record.

NOTE: The information contained in TOEFL/TWE test files is the same as the information printed on your examinee's score record.

TOEFL scores and TWE essay scores are measurement information and are subject to all restrictions on release of information indicated in this *Bulletin*. They are not the property of the examinee.

Ordering Additional Score Reports by Phone

You may also order additional official score reports by telephone. The reports will be mailed approximately three working days after you call. Refer to the dates listed under "Score Report Mailing Dates" on page 20 to find out when score reports for your test date will be available. Do **not** call before the dates listed. Service is normally available from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. New York time, seven days a week. You will need a touch-tone phone and a valid credit card. The fee is US\$12 per call and US\$15 for each score recipient requested. (You will receive a charge on your credit card.) To request more than six score recipients, you will need to call again. Call 1-609-771-7267 to order reports. Because this is an international call, you will receive a charge on your phone bill. People who are hard-of-hearing or speech impaired and have access to a Teletypewriter (TTY) may call 1-609-771-7714.

You will need to have the following near the phone when you call:

- a valid credit card (American Express, Discover, JCB, MasterCard, or VISA only)
- seven-digit registration number (from your admission ticket or score report)
- four-digit test date (month and year)
- four-digit date of birth (month and day)
- institution codes (see List A on pages 28-33)
- department codes (see List B on page 34). Use 00 if you do not need a department code.

IMPORTANT: To be sure that your request is completed, wait for confirmation before hanging up.

Scores Obtained on Different Editions of the Paper-Based TOEFL Test

Slight differences in difficulty from one test to another do occur. However, the method of scoring the test takes these minor differences into account. As an example, a total score of 550 on one edition of the test represents the same level of English proficiency as a score of 550 on another edition.

Score Results for the Test of Written English

The TWE score is reported on a scale of 1 to 6. A score between two points on the scale (5.5, 4.5, 3.5, 2.5, 1.5) can also be reported. The score is printed in a separate box on the TOEFL score report; it is not added to the TOEFL score. Each essay is independently scored by two qualified readers. Neither reader knows the score assigned by the other. In the case of a discrepancy of more than one point, a third reader scores the essay.

If you write an essay on a different topic than the one assigned, your essay will not be scored and your score report will state "Examinee did not write on the assigned topic."

Scores Explanations of TWE Scores

- 6 Demonstrates clear competence in writing on both the rhetorical and syntactic levels, though the essay may have occasional errors.
- 5 Demonstrates competence in writing on both the rhetorical and syntactic levels, though the essay will probably have occasional errors.
- 4 Demonstrates minimal competence in writing on both the rhetorical and syntactic levels.
- 3 Demonstrates some developing competence in writing, but the essay remains flawed on either the rhetorical or syntactic level, or both.
- 2 Suggests incompetence in writing.
- 1 Demonstrates incompetence in writing.

The following codes and explanations may also appear on a TOEFL/TWE score report:

- INR Did not write an essay.
- OFF Did not write on assigned topic.
- ** TWE score not available.

Interpreting Your TWE Score

Use the TWE Percentile Rank Table to help you interpret your score. Assume that your TWE score is 4.5. Under "Your Score" in the table, find the score 4.5. In the "Percentile Rank" column, opposite 4.5, is the number 85. This number means that you achieved a higher score on the TWE test than approximately 85 percent* of all people who took the test from July 2001 through June 2002.

ETS or its authorized representative will also provide information about your scores at the request of an institution or agency that has a copy of your examinee's score record.

NOTE: The information in your TOEFL record is the same as the information printed on your examinee's score record.

Acceptable Scores

Each institution that requires TOEFL scores decides for itself what scores or ranges of scores are acceptable. These requirements vary from institution to institution, depending on such factors as your field of study, your level of study (graduate or undergraduate), whether you will be a teaching assistant, and whether the institution offers special courses in English as a foreign or second language. There is no specific passing or failing score.

If you have questions about how your scores have been used or interpreted, contact the institutions or agencies directly.

TWE Acceptable Scores

There are no passing or failing scores, as such, on the TWE test. Each institution determines for itself whether to use TWE score information in conjunction with TOEFL score information and what score ranges are acceptable. To learn how scores are interpreted, contact the institutions that have received your test results.

Test Score Data Retention

Individually identifiable TOEFL test scores are retained in a database for only two years. After two years, all information that could identify an individual is removed. If you took the TOEFL test more than two years ago, you will have to take the test again to have the scores sent to you, an institution, or an agency.

Confidentiality of

TOEFL Scores

The TOEFL program recognizes the right of examinees to privacy with regard to information that is stored in data or research files held by Educational Testing Service and the program's responsibility to protect information in its files from unauthorized disclosure. ETS or its authorized representative may share examinee score data with institutions or agencies for verification purposes.

TOEFL test score data and essay responses that may be used at any time for informational, research, statistical, or training purposes are not individually identifiable.

Information retained in TOEFL records is the same as the information printed on the examinee's score record and on the official score reports. Official score reports will be sent only to those institutions or agencies designated by the examinee on the day of the test,

on a Score Report Request Form submitted at a later date, or otherwise specifically authorized by the examinee.

Scores are not to be released by institutional recipients without the explicit permission of the examinee.

Test Question Inquiries

Language specialists prepare TOEFL test questions. These specialists follow careful, standardized procedures developed to ensure that all test material is of consistently high quality. Each question is reviewed by several members of the ETS staff. The TOEFL Committee of Examiners, an independent group of professionals in the fields of linguistics, language testing, and language teaching that reports to the TOEFL Board, is responsible for the content of the tests.

After test questions have been reviewed and revised as appropriate, they are selectively administered in trial situations and assembled into computer test pools. The test pools are then reviewed according to established ETS and TOEFL program procedures to ensure that all possible versions of the test are free of cultural bias. Statistical analyses of individual questions, as well as simulated versions of the complete tests, ensure that all items provide appropriate measurement information.

Although ETS employs extensive quality control checks throughout the development of test questions and the preparation of final tests, typographical errors or flaws in questions may occasionally occur. If you suspect a problem and want to question a test item for any reason, notify the test supervisor before you leave the test site. You may also write to TOEFL Test Question Inquiries 42-N-208, Educational Testing Service, Rosedale Road, Princeton, NJ 08541-0001, USA, or send a fax to 1-609-683-2600 immediately after taking the test.

Please include the name of the test, the test date, the name of the center where the test was taken, and, if possible, the number of the test item being questioned.

If you have a complaint about the testing facilities or the supervisor, write to TOEFL Test Administration Services within three days after the test date. Be sure to give the date of the test, the name of the test center, and the city and country in which you tested. ETS Score Cancellation Policy

Test Security Issues

Educational Testing Service strives to report scores that accurately reflect the performance of every test taker. Accordingly, ETS's standards and procedures for administering tests have two primary goals: giving test takers equivalent opportunities to demonstrate their abilities, and preventing any test takers from gaining an unfair advantage over others. To promote these objectives, ETS reserves the right to cancel any test score when, in ETS's judgment a testing irregularity occurs, there is an apparent discrepancy in a test taker's identification, the test taker engages in misconduct, the test taker attempts to use the printed work or ideas of others as their own in the essay section of the test, or the score is invalid for another reason. Reviews of scores by ETS are confidential. When, for any of the above reasons, ETS cancels a test score that has already been reported, it notifies score recipients that the score has been cancelled, but it does not disclose the reason for cancellation except when authorized to do so by the test taker and in certain group cases.

Testing Irregularities

"Testing irregularities" refers to problems with the administration of a test. When testing irregularities occur, they may affect an individual or groups of test takers. Such problems include, without limitation, administrative errors (such as improper timing, improper seating, defective materials, and defective equipment); improper access to test content; and other disruptions of test administrations (such as natural disasters and other emergencies). When

testing irregularities occur, ETS may decline to score the test, or cancel the test score. When in ETS's judgment it is appropriate to do so, ETS gives affected test takers the opportunity to take the test again as soon as possible without charge.

On occasion, weather conditions or other circumstances beyond the test administrator's or ETS's control may require a delayed start or the rescheduling of your test appointment. In the event that a technical problem at the test center makes it necessary to cancel your test session, or if it is later determined that your scores could not be reported, you will be offered the opportunity to retest free of charge or receive a full refund of the original test fee. In addition, you may seek reimbursement from ETS for reasonable and documented expenses associated with traveling to the test center, even though technical problems are generally not the fault of ETS. To request reimbursement, please contact TOEFL Services (see page 39) with the following information within 30 days of your original test date: your name, date of birth, mailing address, daytime telephone number, email address, original test date and registration or CBT appointment number, and a brief description of what occurred at the test center. All reimbursements will be made in U.S. dollars.

Identification Discrepancies

When, in ETS's judgment or the judgment of test center personnel, there is a discrepancy in a test taker's identification, the test taker may be dismissed from the test center; in addition, ETS may decline to score the test or may cancel the test score.

Misconduct

When ETS or test center personnel find that there is misconduct in connection with a test, the test taker may be dismissed from the test center, or ETS may decline to score the test, or may cancel the test score. Misconduct includes, but is not limited to, noncompliance with the "Test Center Procedures and Regulations" found on page 22 of this *Bulletin*.

Plagiarism

ETS reserves the right to cancel the scores of test takers when, in ETS's judgment, there is evidence that an essay includes, for example, text or ideas that are substantially similar to that found in other TOEFL essays; quotations or paraphrasing, without attribution, of language or ideas from published sources. Such essays do not reflect the independent compositional writing skills that the test seeks to measure.

Invalid Scores

ETS may also cancel scores if, in its judgment, there is substantial evidence that they are invalid for any other reason. Evidence of invalid scores may include, without limitation, discrepant handwriting, unusual answer patterns, and inconsistent performance on different parts of the test. Before canceling scores pursuant to this paragraph, ETS notifies the test taker in writing about its concerns, gives the test taker an opportunity to submit information that addresses ETS's concerns, considers any such information submitted, and offers the test taker a choice of options. The options include voluntary score cancellation, a free retest, or arbitration in accordance with ETS's standard Arbitration Agreement. In addition, the test taker is sent a copy of the booklet *Why and How Educational Testing Service Questions Test Scores*, which explains this process in greater detail. (This booklet is available to any test taker at any time on request.)

NOTE: The retest option is not available outside the United States and Canada. The arbitration option is available only for tests administered in the United States.

Although tests are administered under strict supervision and secure conditions, irregularities may sometimes occur. Please contact ETS as soon as possible to report any observed behavior that may lead to an invalid score—for example, someone copying from another test taker, taking a test for someone else, having access to test questions before the exam, or using notes or unauthorized aids. IMPORTANT: If the form is not properly filled out (contains incomplete information, unclear letters, or non-English characters), it MAY cause a delay in your registration and appointment scheduling. Please read the instructions carefully.

Completing the Form

- Use black ink.
- The name given on the form must match the name on the identification document you will present at the test center.

Test Date and Center Information

NOTE: TOEFL is not given every day at all test centers. Contact your RRC for the latest information (see page 17). If you are testing at a paper-based testing center, see page 20.

- Indicate your first five date choices by month (MM) and day (DD); for example, May 21 would be listed as 05/21.
- Indicate the test center number where you want to test, and write out the name of the city where the test center is located. You may also indicate a second-choice center.

Payment Information

- You can fax or mail the form if you pay with a credit card or supply a voucher number.
- You must mail the form if you are submitting a check or other physical payment. For a list of acceptable currencies, see page 4. If your payment is not included with your form, your test appointment will not be held.
- See page 4 for preferred forms of payment, payment policies, and acceptable currencies.

Submitting This Form

- **If you mail the form**, the RRC must receive it at least three weeks prior to your first-choice test date. Insert the form and the proper fee payment in the appropriate envelope provided. Refer to the list of

RRCs on page 17 of this *Bulletin* for the mailing address, and use the correct mailing label provided.

- **If you fax the form**, the RRC must receive the form at least seven days prior to your first-choice test date. Be sure to include your credit card information. Fax it to the appropriate RRC (see page 17 for fax numbers).

Scheduling Process

- When scheduling your appointment, Prometric will try to schedule your first-choice date, then second, third, fourth, or fifth choice in chronological order at your first-choice test center. If you decide to select a second-choice test center, Prometric will then try to schedule your first choice, then second, third, fourth, or fifth choice at your second-choice center. If none of the dates is available, Prometric will try to schedule you for a day closest to your choices.
- If you have a problem with the appointment scheduled for you, contact your RRC.

Retaking the Test

You may **not** take the computer-based TOEFL test more than once per calendar month.

Confirmation Letter

If you do not receive a confirmation of your appointment, you must call the RRC at least **three business days** prior to your first-choice appointment. If your choices are not in order by date, you must call the RRC at least three business days prior to the earliest appointment choice.
