

2010 EASTSIDE QUILTERS RAFFLE QUILT

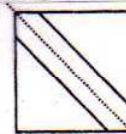
RAILS WITH ATTITUDE

9" finished block – **make 2 (a Unit C and a Unit D)**

Pinks and browns with light background (*Note: Please use various pinks and browns so we can achieve a very scrappy quilt. Thank you*)

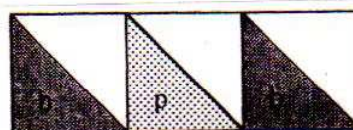
- Cut 4 - 4 ¼" squares light (light fabric provided)
- Cut 2 - 4 ¼" squares pink (cut DIFFERENT pinks)
- Cut 2 - 4 ¼" squares brown (cut DIFFERENT browns)
- Cut 2 - 3 ½" x 9 ½" rectangles pink (cut DIFFERENT pinks)
- Cut 2 - 3 ½" x 9 ½" rectangles brown (cut DIFFERENT browns)

1. Stack a light 4 ¼" square and a pink 4 ¼" square right sides together and mark a diagonal line from corner to corner. Stitch a scant 1/4" on both sides of the diagonal line. Cut on the diagonal line to make 2 half-square triangles. Press to dark. Square these half-square triangles to 3 ½" square.
2. Repeat step 1 with another light and pink square combination.
3. Repeat step 1 twice with a light and brown combination.
4. You will have 4 half-square triangles of the light/pink combination and 4 half-square triangles of the light/brown combination. You will only use 3 of each. You may turn in the other two, if you wish, so they may use them to make other blocks.
5. Sew 3 sets of half-square triangles together to make a 3 ½" x 9 ½" rectangle. **Be careful to keep the units in their correct order.** See below for Unit A and Unit B.



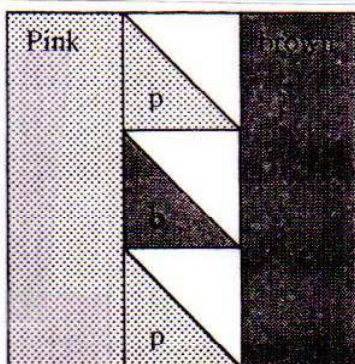
p = pink

unit A

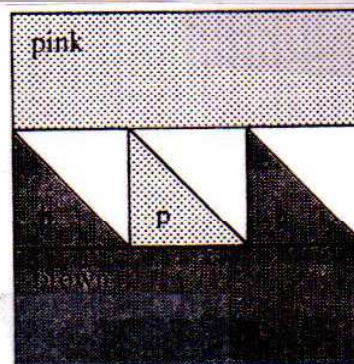

6. Sew a pink 3 ½" x 9 ½" rectangle to the left and a brown 3 ½" x 9 ½" rectangle to the right of Unit A. This will make Unit C.
7. Sew a pink 3 ½" x 9 ½" rectangle to the top and a brown 3 ½" x 9 ½" rectangle to the bottom of Unit B. This will make Unit D.
8. Press seams toward rectangles. Blocks should measure 9 ½" x 9 ½".
