

# Dancing Pinwheels

(Finished size 10"; unfinished 10 1/2")

## CUTTING:

Black (provided)

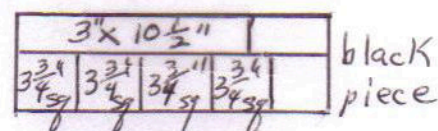
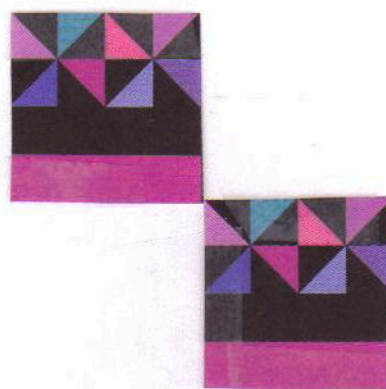
1<sup>st</sup> cut: 3" x 10 1/2" strip (**d**)

2<sup>nd</sup> cut: (4) 3 3/4" x 3 3/4" squares (**E**)

Solid Brights (4)

1<sup>st</sup> cut: Cut one color into a 3" x 10 1/2" strip (**d**)

2<sup>nd</sup> cuts: Cut (4) 3 3/4" x 3 3/4" squares [1 of each of the 4 solid colors] (**E**)



## ASSEMBLY:

1. Mark diagonal line on the back of each of the 4 solid color squares (**E**)
2. Place a color square with a black square (right sides together).
3. Sew 1/4" on each side of the diagonal line.
4. Cut on the diagonal line and press seam to black.
5. Square it up to 3".
6. Repeat with the other 3 colors and black squares. After squaring you will have a total of 8 half square triangles.
7. Arrange the squares as shown in the diagram (see color variation on top of this page to get placement of the black.)
8. Sew the first 4 together to make a pinwheel (matching center points) and then the second group of 4 to make the second pinwheel.
9. Hint: Before sewing the center points, press that seam open – seam will have less bulk. Each pinwheel should be 5 1/2" square.
10. Sew the 2 pinwheel squares together and press seam open at point – ends press toward black.
11. Sew (**d**) black 3" x 10 1/2" strip to pinwheels. Press seam away from pinwheels.
12. Sew (**d**) color 3" x 10 1/2" strip to above. Press seam to color strip.
