This makes a 10" finished block; 10 1/2" unfinished.

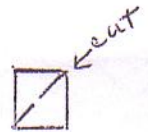
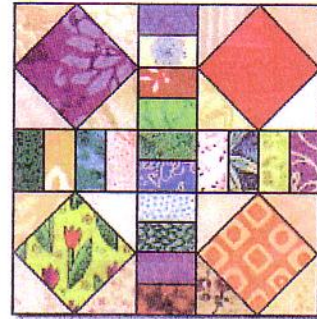
Materials and Cutting:

Medium/Dark prints:

- Cut 18 different 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles.
- Cut 4 different 3 3/8" squares.

Tan/Cream fabrics:

- Cut 8 different tan/cream fabrics into 3" squares; then cut in half across diagonal to make 16 half square triangles.

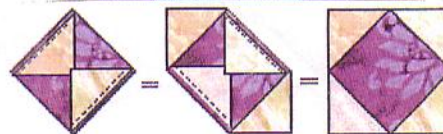


Assembly:

- Sew together one strip of 10 different colored rectangles; press seams as indicated.
- Sew 2 units of 4 different rectangles each; press seams all in one direction.



- Sew the different tan half square triangles to the 3 3/8" squares.
- Press seams out and trim unit to 4 1/2" square. Make 4 different units like this.



- Sew the shorter rectangle units between 2 corner units; press seams to corner units. *Note:* Match point of square to center seam of short rectangle unit.
- Then sew the above units to the longer rectangle unit; press seams to long rectangle unit. *Note:* Match point of square to appropriate seam of long rectangle unit.
