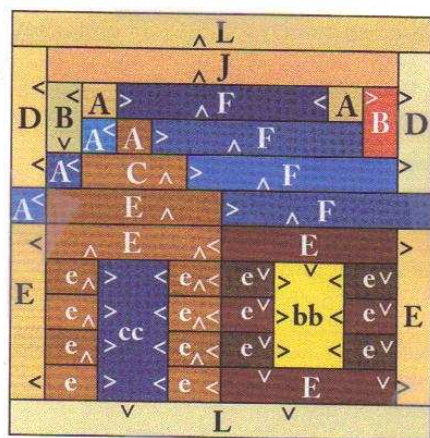

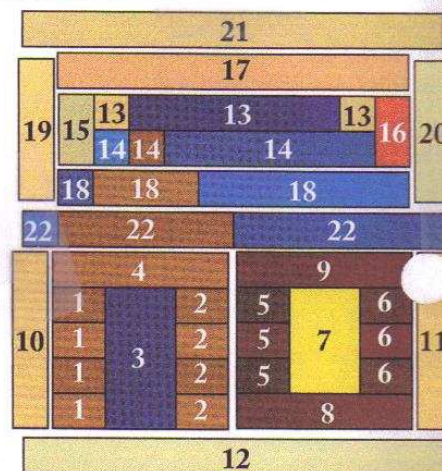

Y Block Patches



Y Piecing Sequence

Arrange the Patches for Y Block according to the block diagram above on left.

Piece the patches in numerical order as shown in the diagram above on right.

Join all neighboring patches labeled with the same number to each other before assembling the block in numerical order.

Press seam allowances in the direction indicated by the arrows (< or >) in the Block Patches diagram.
