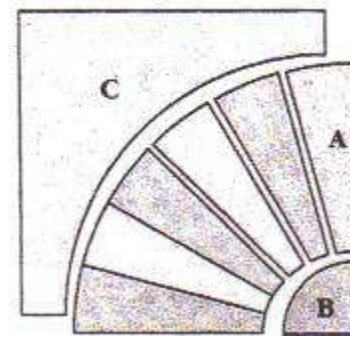


## PASTEL FANS

Finished: 10 ½" (cut 11")

### Materials:

- 6 - 1930's or bright pastel prints (your choice) for Fans
- 1 - 1930's color solid or read as solid bright pastel (your choice)
- 1 - Neutral background (provided)



**Block assembly diagram**

### Cutting:

Using Template A: cut a fan from each of the 6 colors

Using Template B: cut fan base from the solid or read as solid (**NOTE: It is recommended that you add a little more than an 1/8" to each side of the straight edges for ease in squaring up the block**)

Using Template C: cut the background from fabric provided.

### Assembly:

1. Cut pieces as indicated above from templates.
2. Sew Fan pieces together with ¼" seam. Press seams open.
3. Sew **or** appliqué "B" piece on to "A" fan pieces with ¼" seam. See below hints on sewing curves. Press seam to B section.
4. Sew "C" piece to top of "A" fan pieces with ¼" seam. Press seams to C section.
5. Do **NOT** square up block – let recipient do this. You should have a block that she may square up to 11".

Stay-stitch just inside the seam allowances of both the convex and concave curves. Clip to the stitching on the concave curve. With right sides facing and raw edges aligned, pin the centers together. (See Figure 2.) Next pin the convex piece to the concave piece at the left edge. (See Figure 3.) Carefully sew from the edge to the center, stopping frequently to check that raw edges are aligned. Stop at the center with your needle down. Raise the presser foot and pin the pieces together at the right edge. Sew from the center to the right edge, checking frequently to see that raw edges are aligned.
