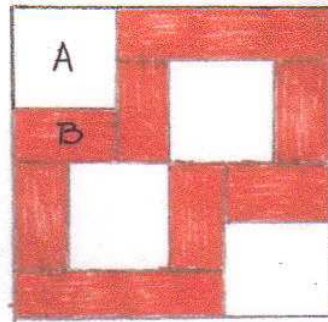


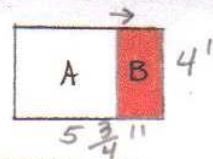
PATIENCE CORNER
Block size 11 unfinished



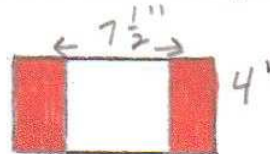
You will need red & white toile (fabric A provided) and red fabric of your choice.

Cut the toile fabric into four 4" squares, and a red tone on tone (fabric B) of your choice into 2-1/4" strips. A fat quarter will do.

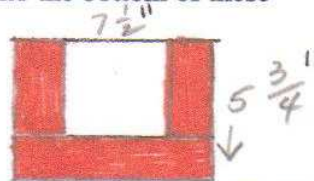
Stitch a strip of red fabric B onto one side of each 4" fabric A square, as shown, press toward the red. Set two of these pieces aside until later*



Now stitch an additional red strip onto the opposite side of TWO of the squares, forming 2 rectangles.



To these two pieces, stitch an additional strip of red onto the bottom of these rectangles.



Next, attach the remaining two pieces that have been set aside* to the right side of the above pieces, repeat with second half. Press well, turn one piece upside down and connect the two halves to make the block, *matching centers.*
