

Quilter of the Lake

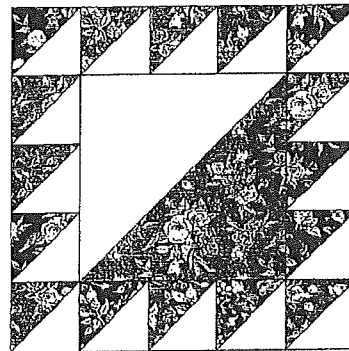
(AKA Lady of the Lake)

10" finished block

Fabric A - Large print provided

Fabric B - Ecrú tone on tone

Fabric C - Medium to dark floral scraps to coordinate with Fabric A
(may use leftovers of Fabric A also)



Cutting:

Fabric A - Cut 1 - 7" square

Fabric B - Cut 1 - 7" square
Cut 8 - 3" squares

Fabric C - Cut 8 - 3" squares

Sewing:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 7" ecru square. With right sides together of 7" Fabric A and 7" ecru, sew a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " on one side of the diagonal line. (Yes, only one side, unless you plan on making two blocks.)

Cut on the drawn line and press towards Fabric A.

Trim to 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 3" ecru squares. Place 3" scrap squares (Fabric C) and 3" ecru squares right sides together and sew a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " away on both sides of the drawn line.

Cut apart on the drawn line and press towards the scrap fabric (dark).

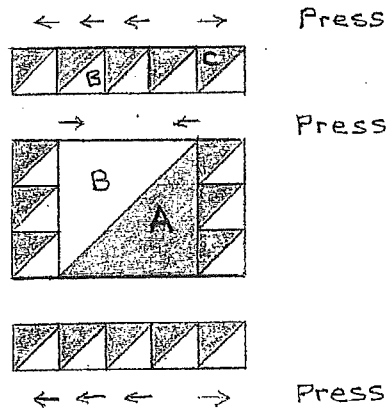
Trim to 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Join 5 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " units as shown for the top and bottom row.

Join 3 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " units as shown for center row and then join them to the 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " center unit. Press towards the center.

Sew the top and bottom rows to the center row

Press towards the center.
