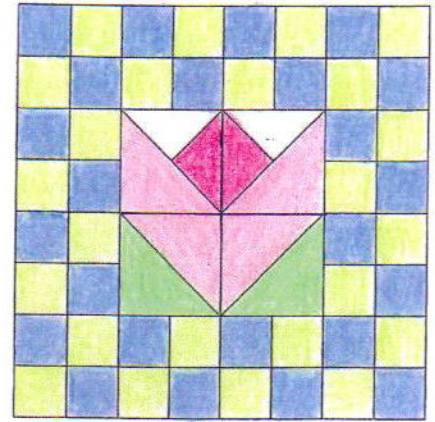


Tulip Tile



FABRIC REQUIRED

- Y = Yellow – (4) 2" x 12 1/2" Strips – Cut from fabric provided
- N = Navy – (4) 2" x 12 1/2" Strips – Cut from fabric provided
- G = Green – (1) 3 7/8" x 3 7/8" Square
- W = White Tone-on-Tone - (1) 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" square
- J = Jewel Tone – (2) 3 7/8" x 3 7/8" square
- J1 = Similar Jewel Tone (1) 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" square

BLOCK BORDER

- 1) Sew four strip sets of 1 yellow & 1 navy strip. Press to the navy.
- 2) Cut all four strip sets into 2" sections. You need 24 sections.
- 3) Sew the sections to form 12 four patches.
- 4) Join the four patches into border sections as shown in diagram 4.

FLOWER

- 1) Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of green 3 7/8" square.
- 2) Layer one 3 7/8" jewel tone (J) square and the 3 7/8" green square, right sides together. Sew scant 1/4" seam on each side of your drawn line. Cut apart on your drawn line. Press to the green. *Square to 3 1/2"*
- 3) Cut the 4 1/4" jewel tone (J1) square diagonally, twice. You will only use two of the resulting triangles for one block.
- 4) Cut the 4 1/4" white square diagonally, twice. You will only need two of the white triangles for one block.
- 5) Sew one white triangle to one jewel tone (J1) triangle as shown in diagram 1. Sew the other pair as shown in diagram 2. Press to the jewel tone.
- 6) Cut the remaining 3 7/8" jewel tone (J) triangle in half diagonally once. Join each of these triangles to the white / jewel tone pairs of triangles to form a square. Press to the large triangle. *Square to 3 1/2"*
- 7) Join the flower sections as shown in diagram 3.
- 8) Add the checkered border sections to complete your block which should measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished. Refer to diagram 4.

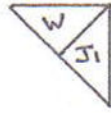

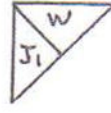

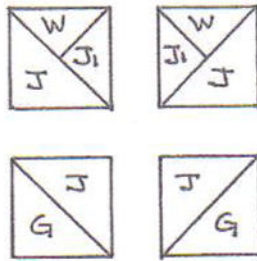
