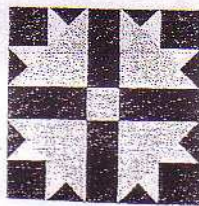


Turkey Tracks

Brown background – provided

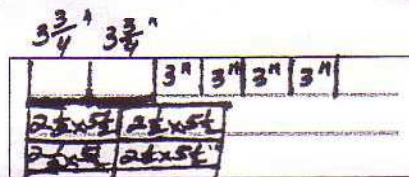
Golds, yellows, oranges, peaches – you provide



Cutting:

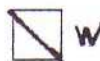
Background (brown provided) *fat eighth yard*

- Cut 2 - $3\frac{3}{4}$ " squares; cut diagonal twice (q)
- Cut 4 - 3" squares (#11)
- Cut 4 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (#44)



Golds, yellows, oranges, peaches – you provide

- Cut 2 - 6" squares; cut diagonal once (w)



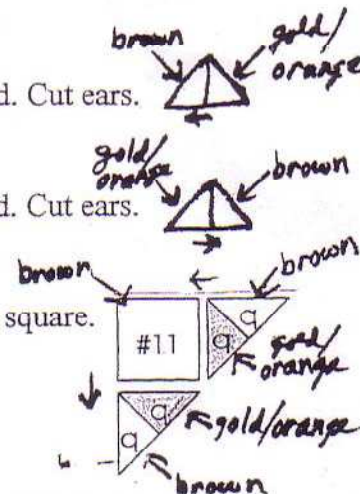
- Cut 2 - $3\frac{3}{4}$ " squares; cut diagonal twice (q)



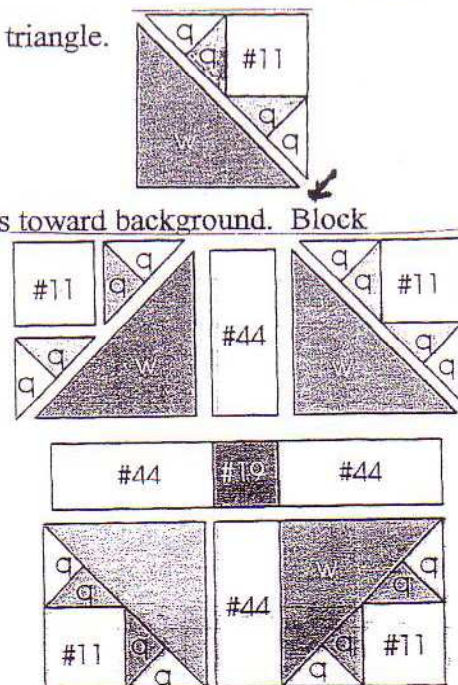
- Cut 1 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square (#19)

Block Assembly:

1. Sew 4 background "q" to 4 orange/gold "q". Press toward background. Cut ears.
2. Sew 4 orange/gold "q" to 4 background "q". Press toward background. Cut ears.
3. Sew #11 background square to q/q pieces as shown. Press toward #11 square.
4. Sew above unit to q/q pieces as shown. Press to q/q triangle unit.
5. Center and sew above unit to "w" triangle. Press to "w" triangle.
6. Square to $5\frac{1}{2}$ ".
7. Make 4 units as above.



8. Lay out pieces as below and sew into block. Press seams toward background. Block should measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
