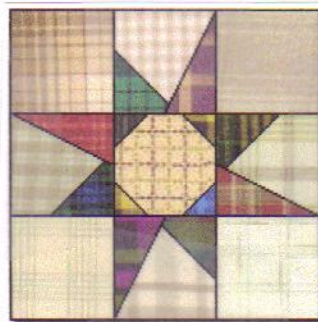


# ★ Uneven Star



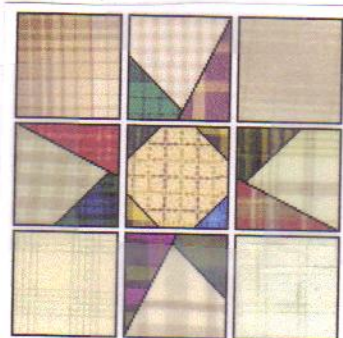
9" block

## Materials and Cutting:

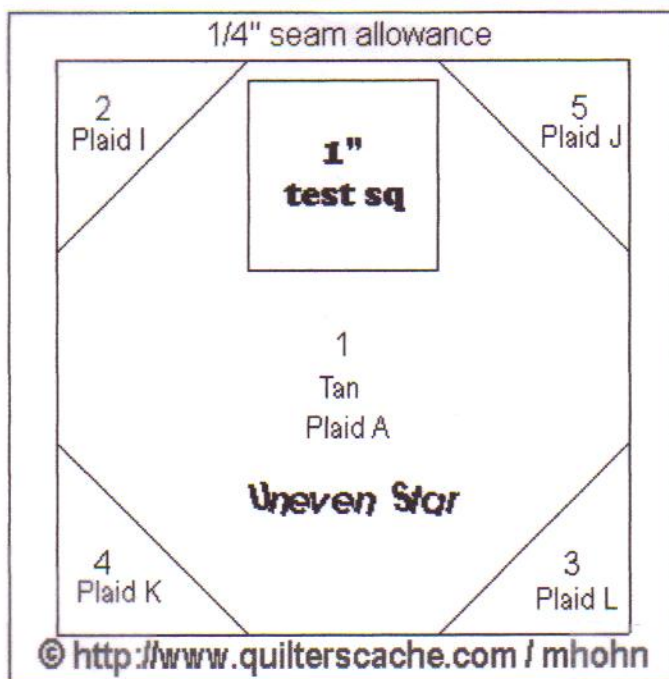
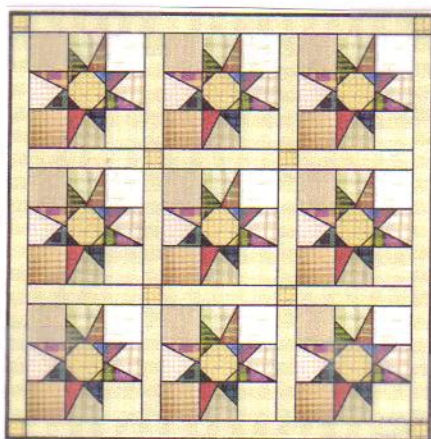
- Center (provided)
- Cut 4 different ecru squares – 3 ½" x 3 ½" for corners
- 12 different scraps (medium/dark prints) for star points and for center unit corners.
- 4 different ecru scraps for the background in the star point units.

## Assembly:

- Paper piece the 4 corners on the center unit
- Square to 3 ½"
- Paper piece the 4 Star point units using various medium/dark prints
- Square each to 3 ½"
- Lay the units out as shown in diagram
- Sew three horizontal rows, pressing the top and bottom row seams to the outside, and the middle row seams to the center.
- Join the rows and you've finished the block.



Note: Before sewing the fabrics to the paper, perforate each unit on the lines. This will make it easier to remove paper. Also, use lightweight paper.
