There is no limit as to the number of shows at which the dog may be entered as a listed dog; however, the Canadian Kennel Club does not confer a title on any dog until it is registered individually in the Club's records.

Exhibitors must abide by errors made by entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Alterations, substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the Closing Date is prohibited, except moving Class Dogs to Specials. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to C.K.C. rules. **ENTRIES POSITIVELY CLOSE 9:00 P.M. TUESDAY, APRIL 15, 2003** and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date. Identification cards and Judging Schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification Cards must be presented upon arrival at the show. ### EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective January 1, 1997, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering C.K.C. events will no longer require a C.K.C. registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). ## CHAMPIONSHIPS and CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 20 Section 1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

Chapter 20 Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points allocated a dog WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

\* includes the dog awarded Winners

**(New for 2003)** In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Show Superintendent will be in complete charge of the show which will be governed by C.K.C. rules.
2. All exercise pens must have plastic sheeting underneath and up the sides. If space is limited, exercise pens will have to be taken down during the show hours as requested by the Show Superintendent.
3. E.S.S.C.C. will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
4. The Board of Directors of the C.K.C. has ruled where a conflict arises between the Breed Standards and the Dog Show Rules that the Dog Show Rules will take precedence.
5. If because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management; it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.
6. Dogs need only arrive 15 minutes before scheduled judging time and will be excused when not required for further judging. If the dog is not at ringside after it has been called three times, it will be marked absent. Delays waiting for dogs will not be possible and it is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have the dog at ringside at the scheduled time.
7. SHOW PRECINCTS: The Show Precincts shall consist of all areas set out for rings, all shelters or facilities set aside for show officials and judges.

### MOVING DOGS TO SPECIALS

**Chapter 13, Section 8.** The Dog Show Rules have been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the closing for entries for a Show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to 'Specials Only', providing the request for transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the Specialty show, by the owner or handler.

## CONFORMATION CLASSES OFFERED

### REGULAR CLASSES

**JUNIOR PUPPY DOG/BITCH** - dogs/bitches 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show.

**SENIOR PUPPY DOG/BITCH** - dogs/bitches 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show.

**JUNIOR DOG/BITCH** - dogs/bitches 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

**BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG/BITCH** - dogs/bitches owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner and breeder/co-breeder of the dogs/bitches. The owner/breeder must handle the dogs/bitches in this class, but need not handle the dogs/bitches for further awards.

**CANADIAN BRED DOG/BITCH** - Dogs/bitches born in Canada

**OPEN DOG/BITCH** - all dogs/bitches

**VETERAN DOG/BITCH** - dogs/bitches 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs/bitches entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

**SPECIALS ONLY** - dogs/bitches which have recorded a CKC registration number or ERN and have attained the required points for Championship status. Dogs/bitches entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES

**EXHIBITION ONLY** - a dogs/bitches entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes.

**STUD DOG** for the Stud Dog and two of his Get. The Stud Dog must be entered in a Regular Class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular Class.

**BROOD BITCH** for the Brood Bitch and two of her Brood. The Brood Bitch must be entered in a Regular Class or in Exhibition Only. Brood must be entered in a Regular Class.

**BRACE** for two dogs of the same breed which have IDENTICAL ownership. Spayed/neutered dogs may be entered in the Brace. Both dogs must be entered in at least one of the above Regular Classes or Exhibition Only

### PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

*The following classes will be offered:*

Junior Puppy (6 - 9 months), Senior Puppy (9 - 12 months), Junior (12 - 18 months). The classes are divided by sex. All First place winners in each class will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite in Sweepstakes.

**All dogs entering Sweepstakes must be entered in one of the Regular Classes.**

30% of each class intake goes to First in class

30% of total intake goes to Best in Sweeps & a Rosette

20% of total intake goes to Best of Opposite & a Rosette

### VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

*The following classes will be offered:*

7 - 9 years; 9-11 years; and 11 years and older. All classes are divided by sex. All First place winners in each class will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite in Sweepstakes.

**Dogs entering Veteran Sweepstakes may be spayed/neutered provided they are entered in either Veteran Dog/Bitch class or Exhibition Only.**

30% of each class intake goes to First in class

30% of total intake goes to Best in Sweeps & a Rosette

20% of total intake goes to Best of Opposite & a Rosette

## ALTERED CLASSES

Judges shall judge these classes as if judging regular conformation classes following the breed standard for English Springer Spaniels. Eligibility for the Altered Classes shall be limited to dogs/bitches over the age of 6 months which have not attained their CKC championship and which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. There are no age divisions within the classes. First place in their respective classes is awarded **WINNERS ALTERED MALE / FEMALE**.
